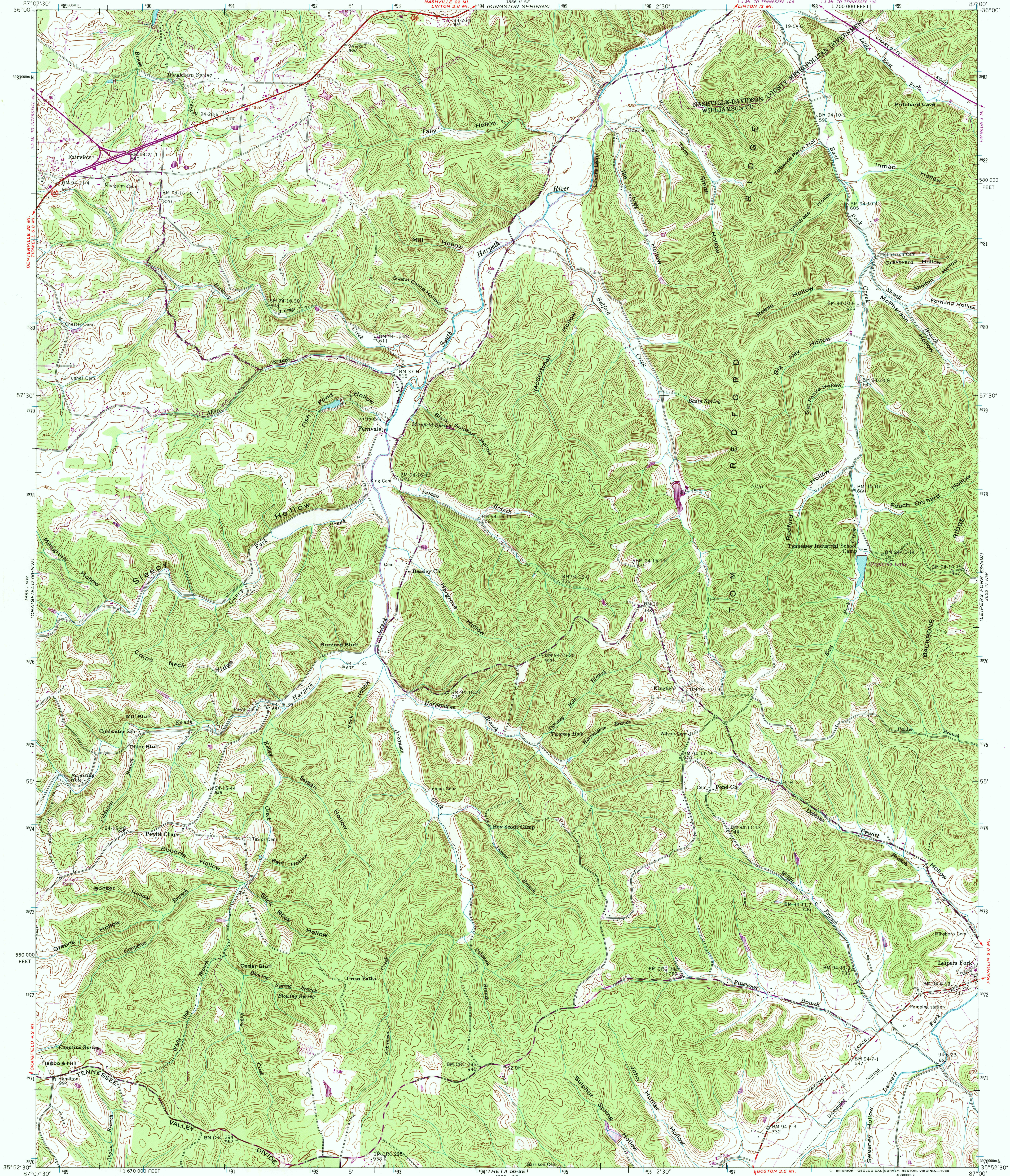

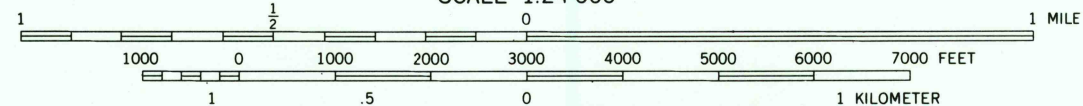
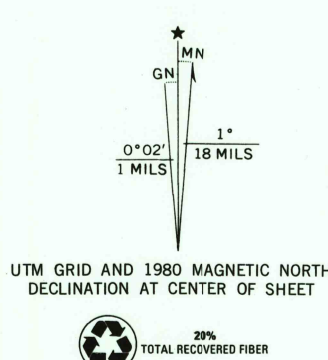
Polyconic projection

dashed corner ticks

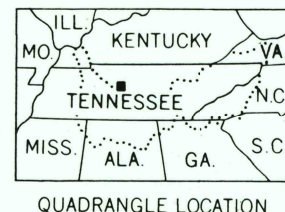
