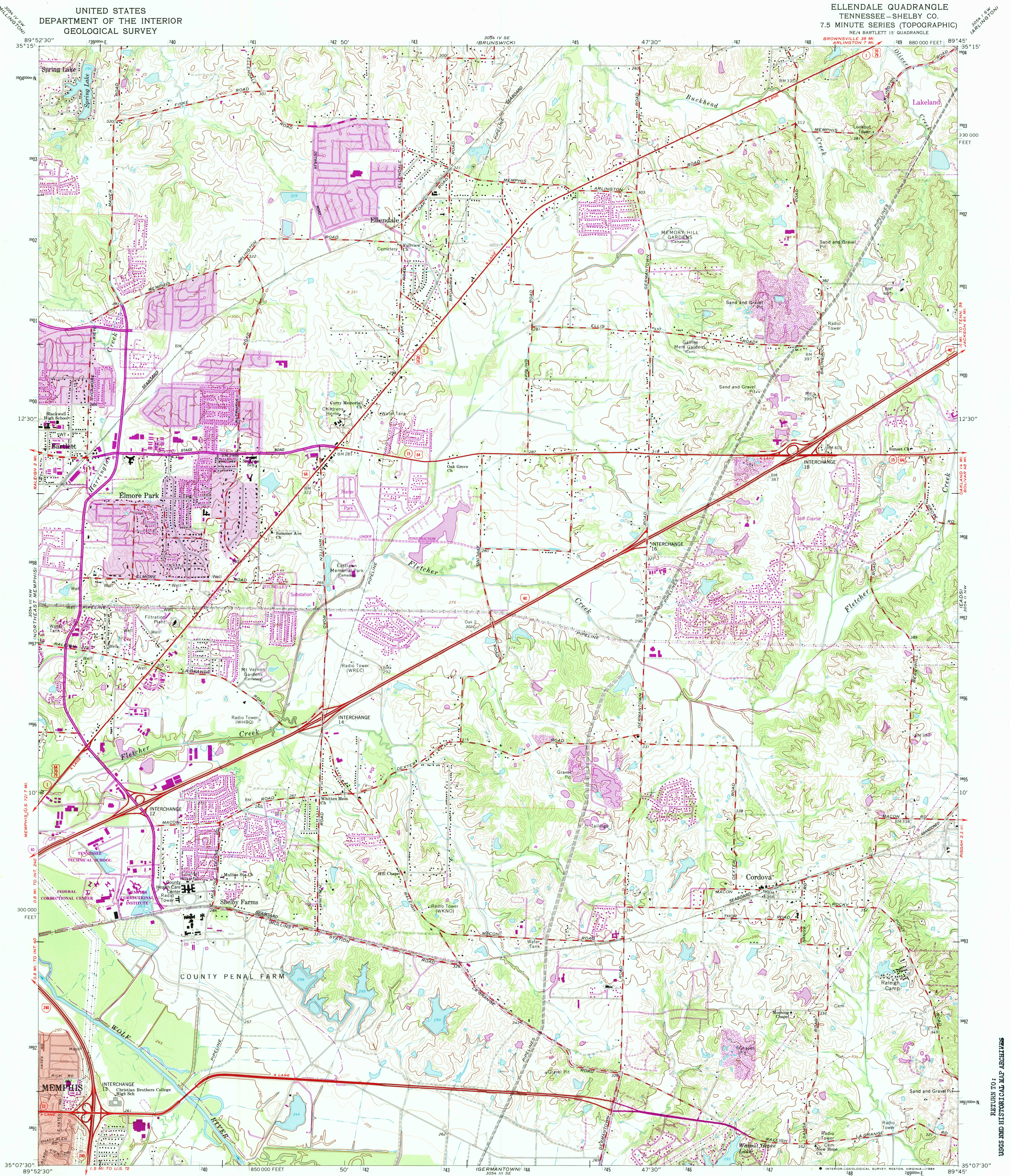

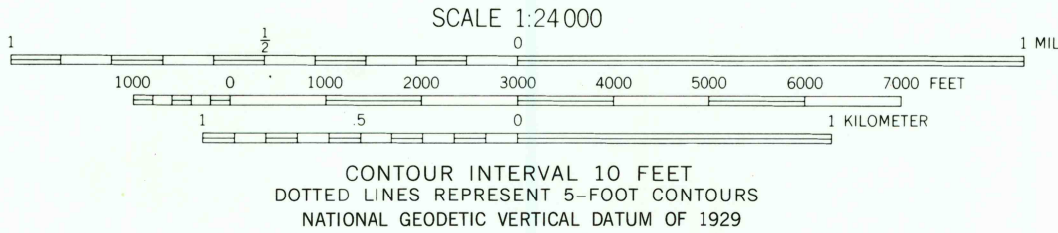
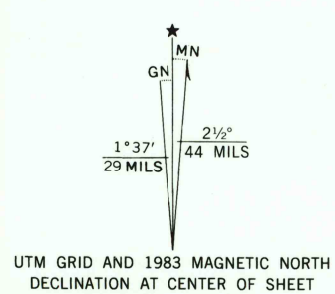
Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Tennessee coordinate system
