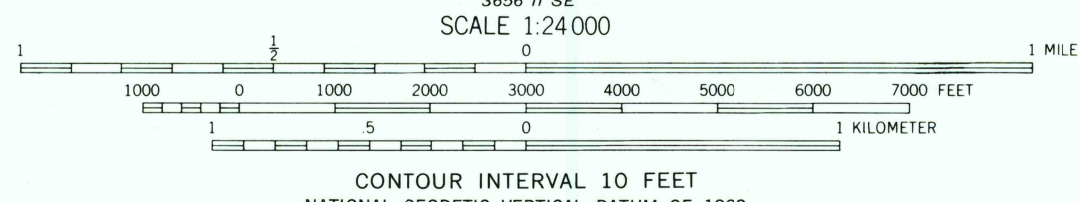

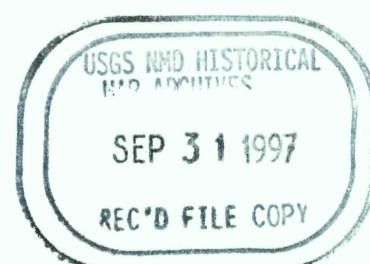
UTM GRID AND 1983 MAGNETIC NORTH
