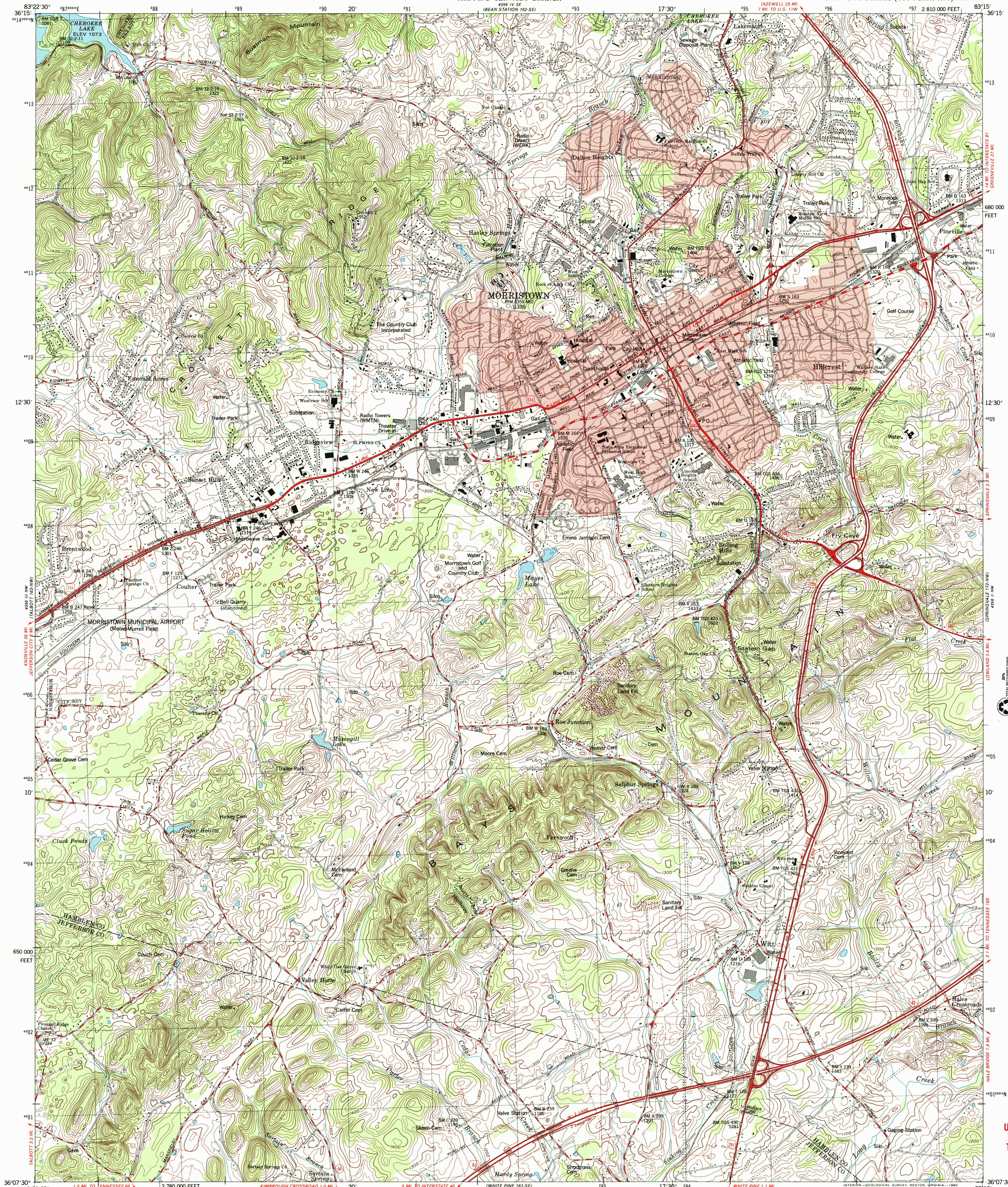




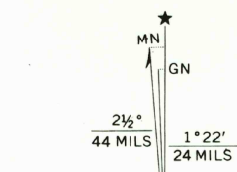

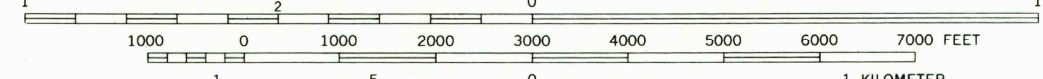
Polyconic projection, 1927 North American datum

visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked



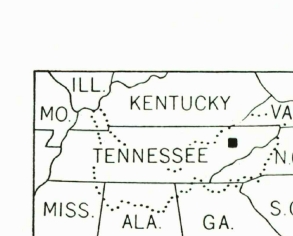
UTM GRID AND 1979 MAGNETIC NORTH
