

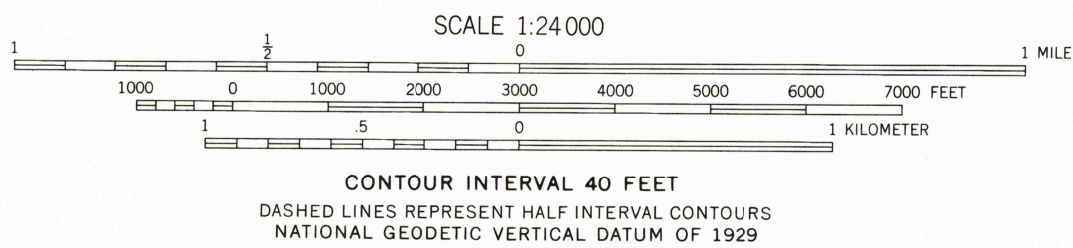
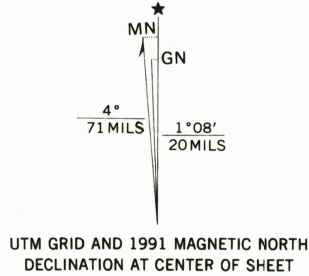

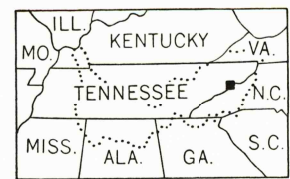
PAINT ROCK QUADRANGLE
