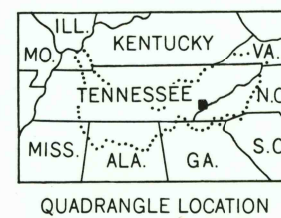
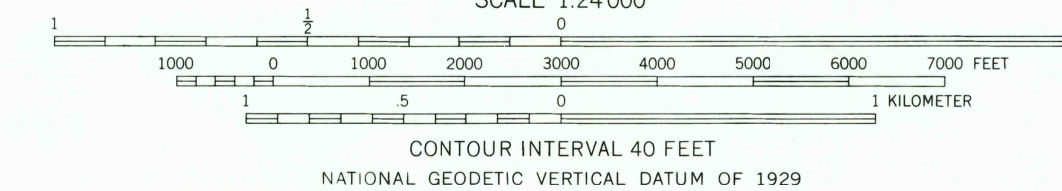

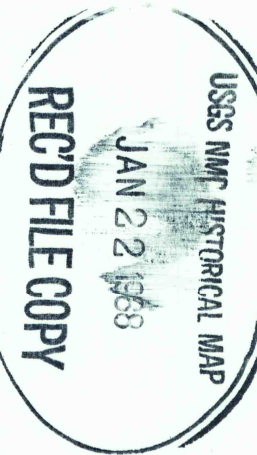
UTM GRID AND 1978 MAGNETIC NORTH
