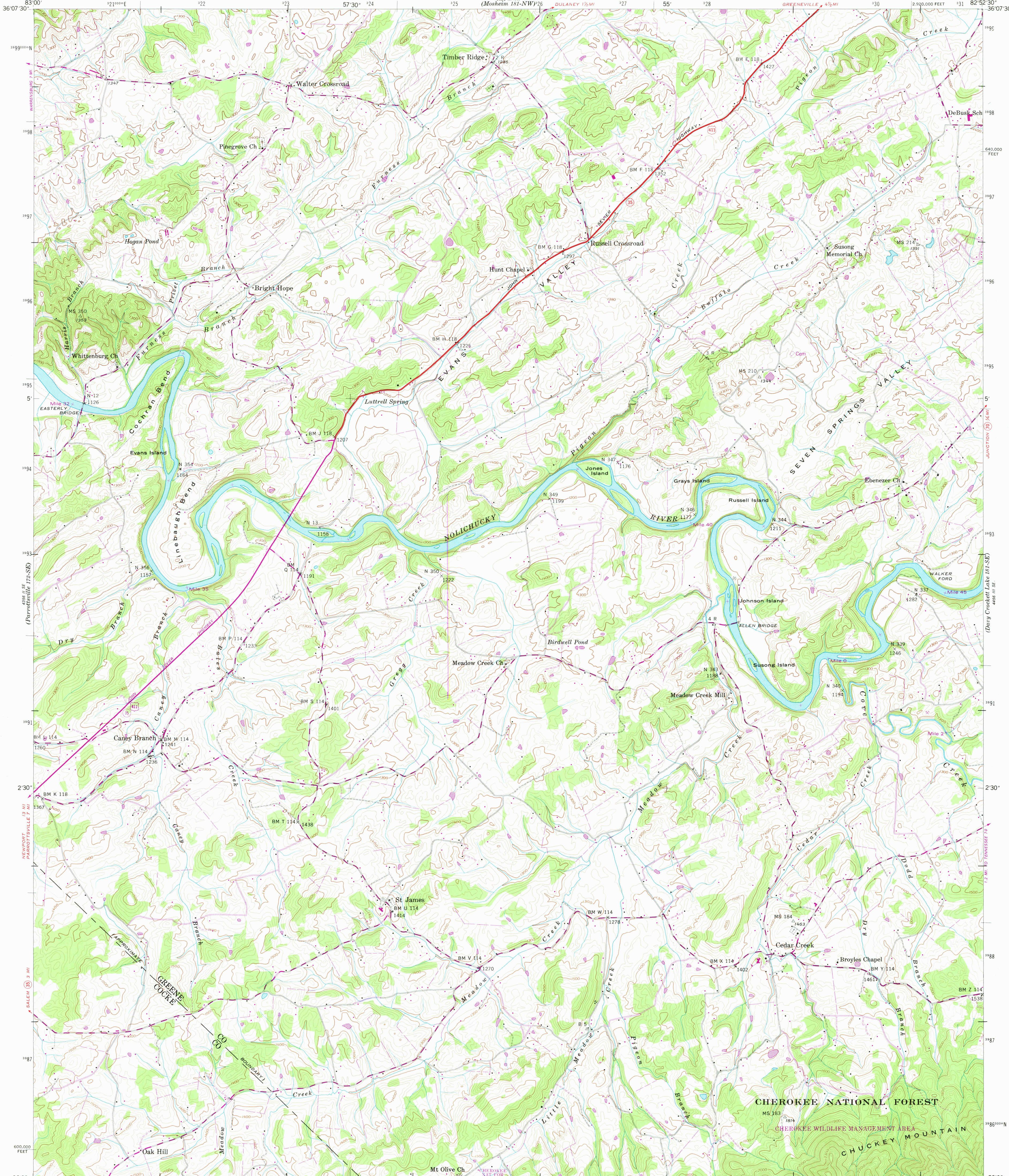




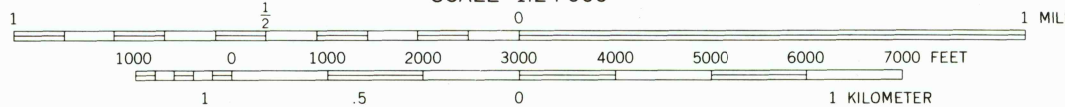
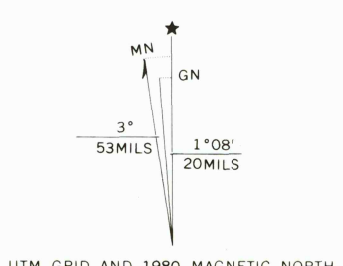

7 meters south and 11 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

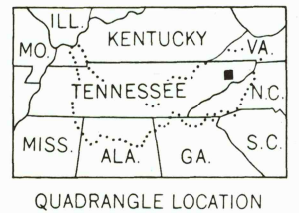
