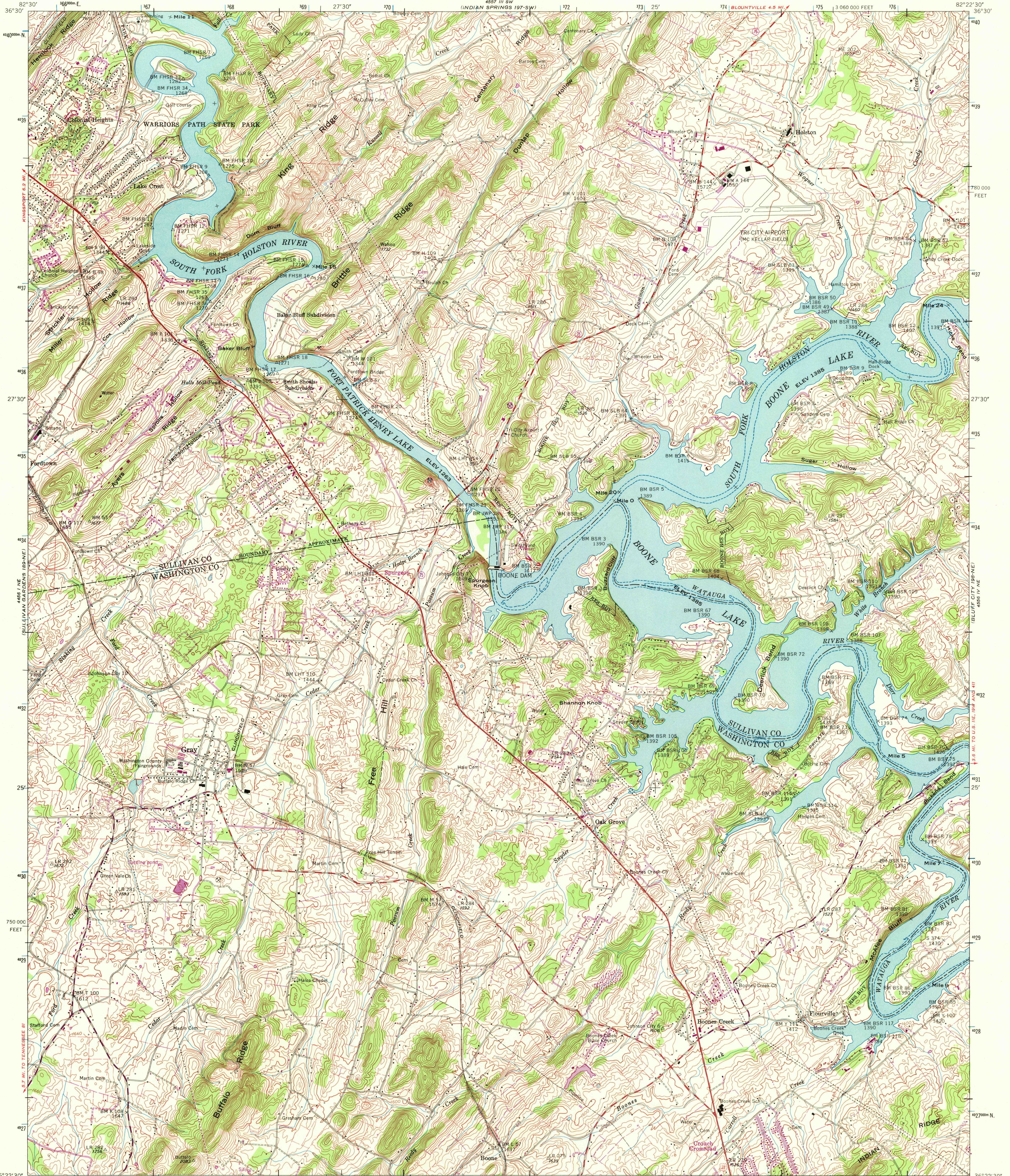

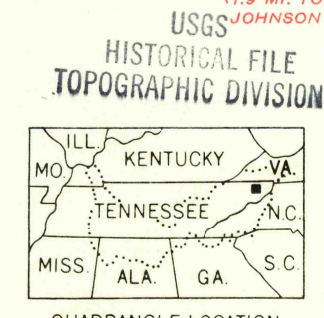
BOONE DAM QUADRANGLE
