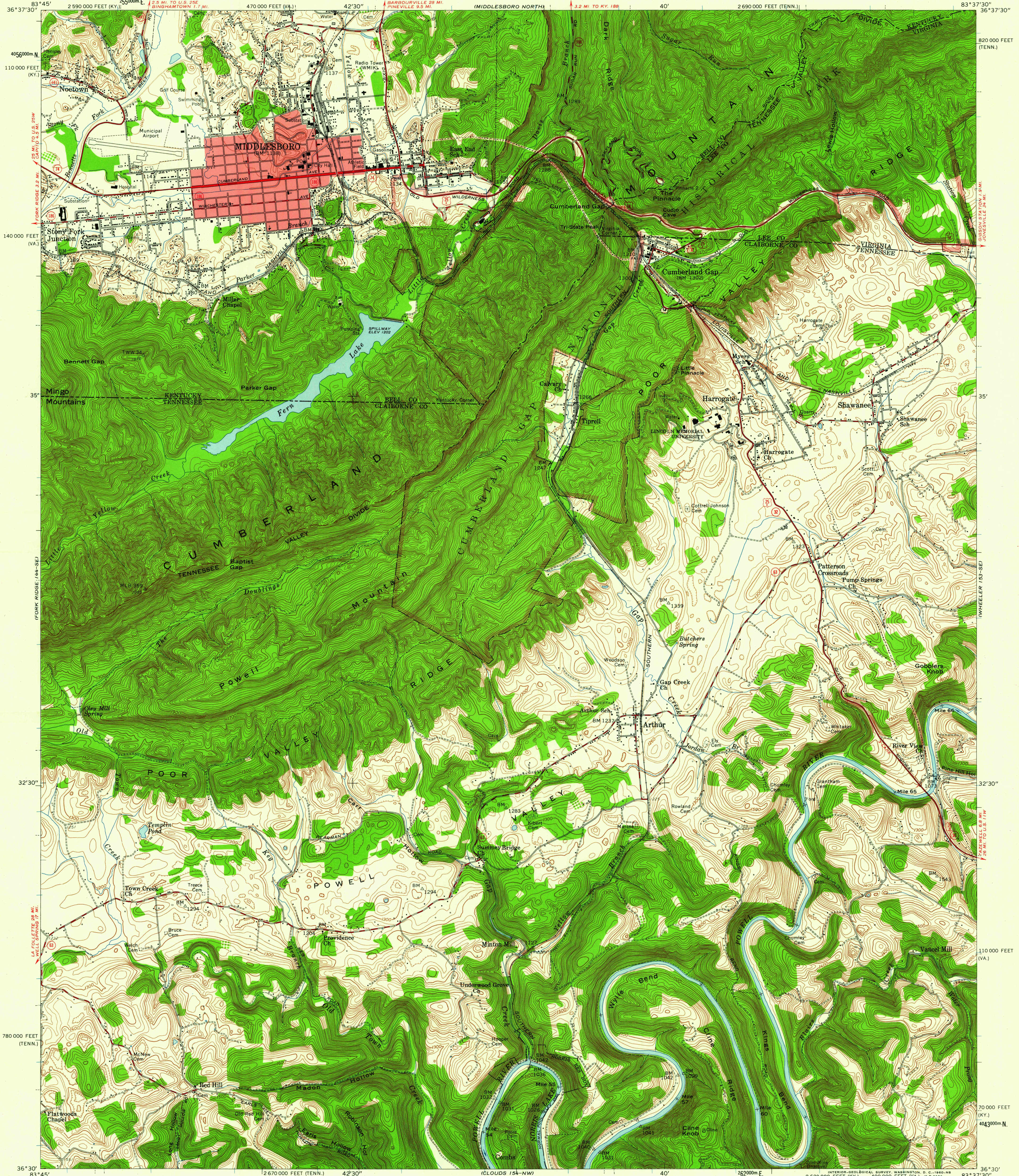


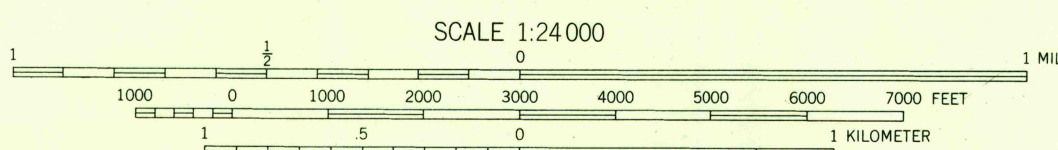

zone 17, shown in blue

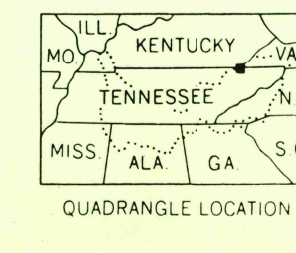
Red tint indicates area in which only
