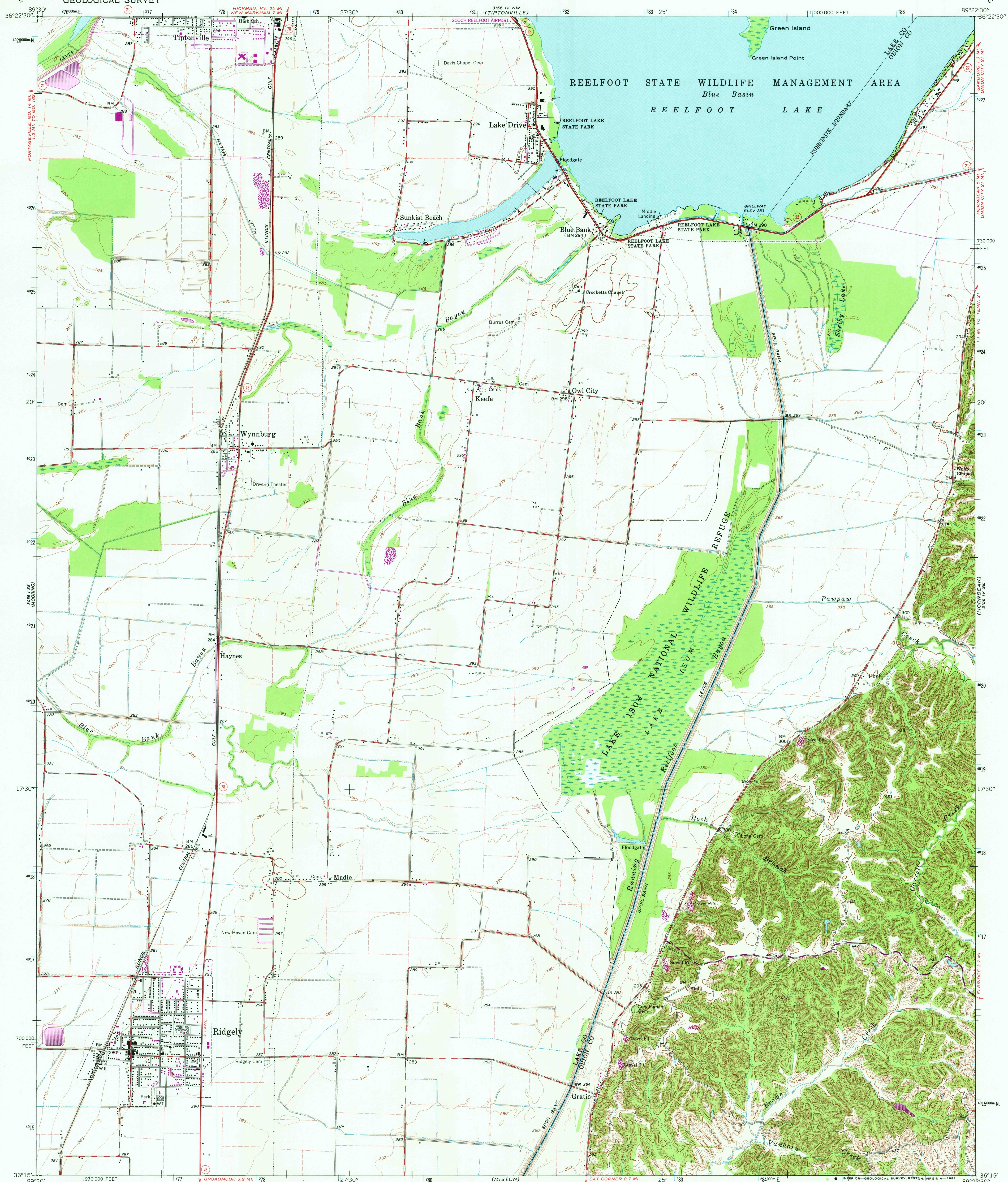

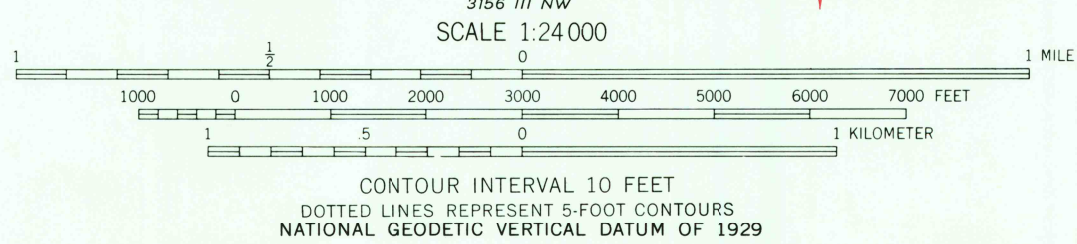

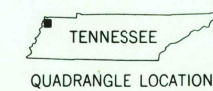
Polyconic projection
