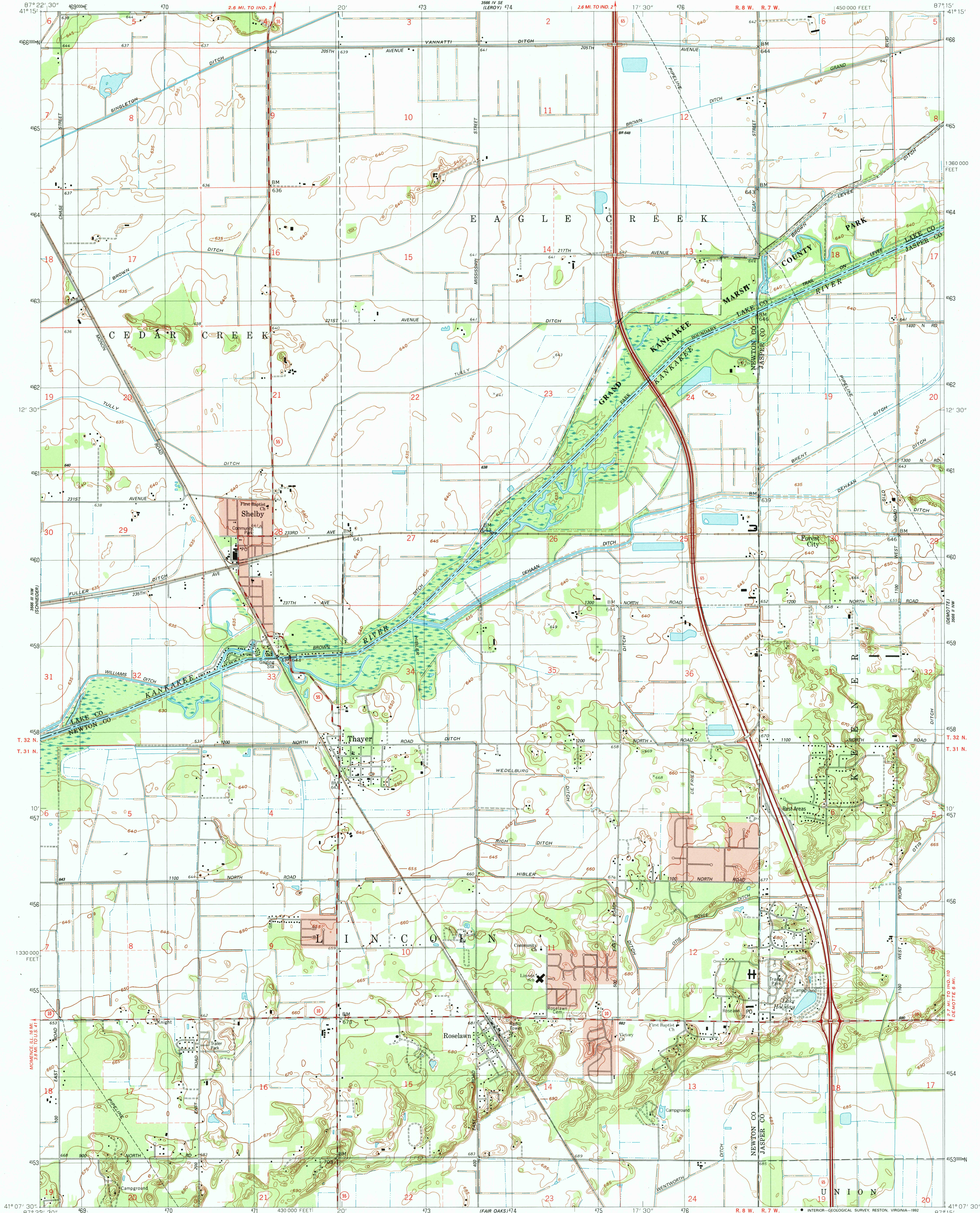

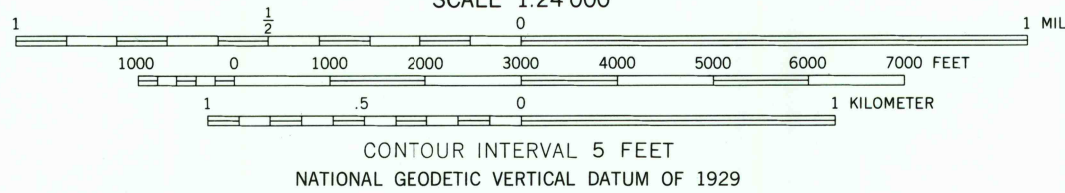
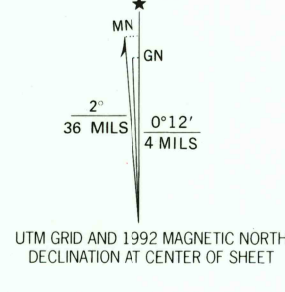
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 16

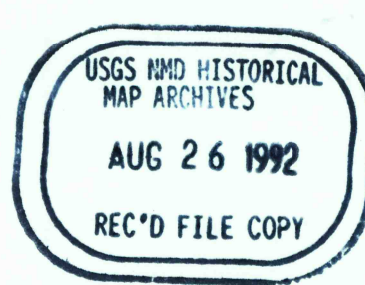
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
