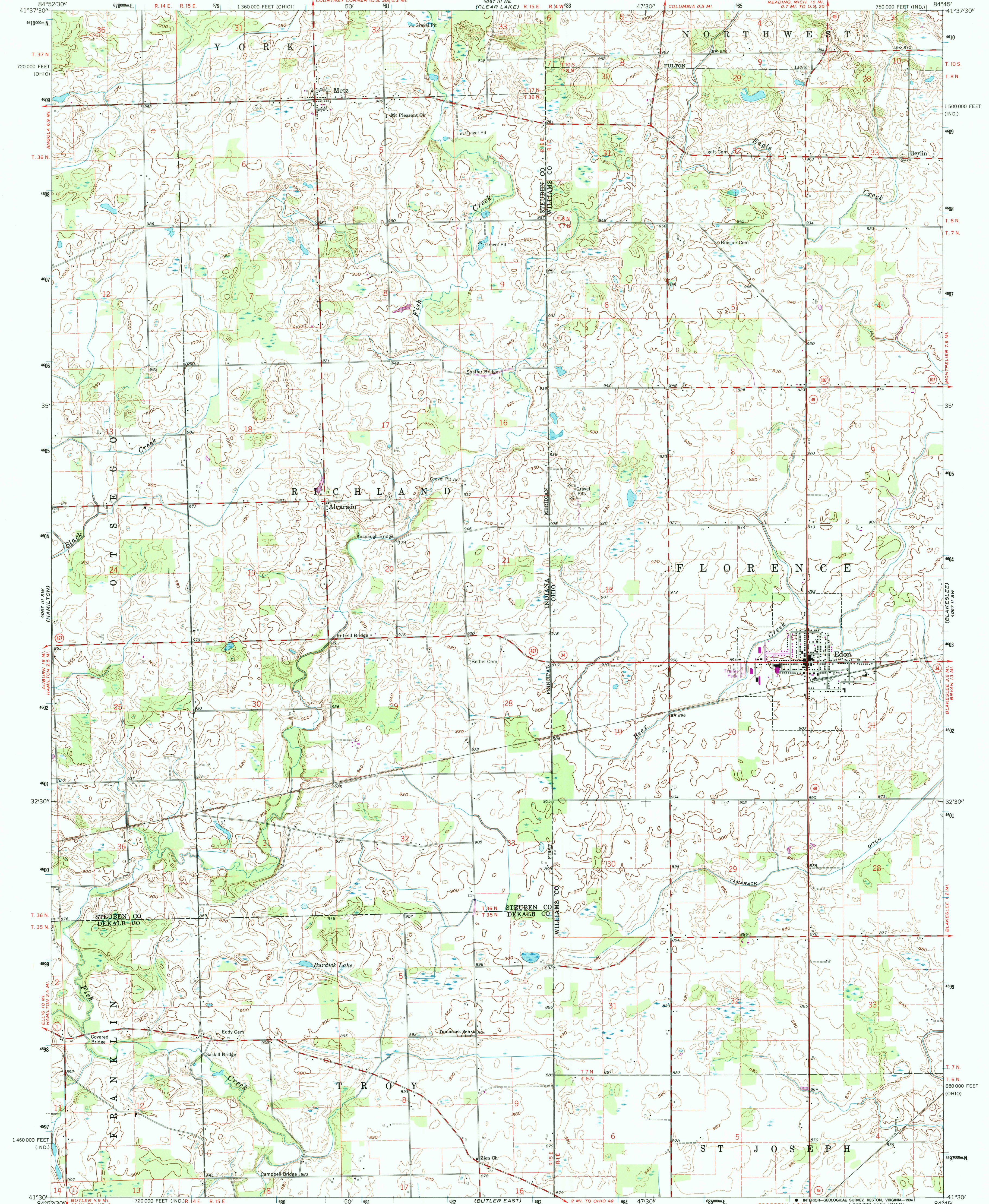


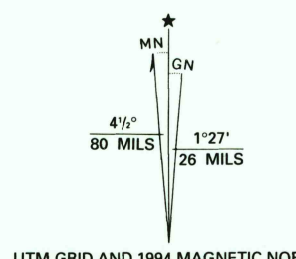

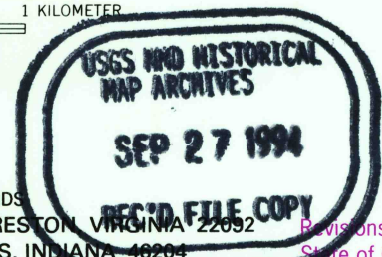

(transverse Mercator).  
10 000-foot ticks: Indiana coordinate system, east zone and  
Ohio coordinate system, north zone  
Blue 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16  
North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83) is shown by dashed  
corner ticks. The values of the shift between NAD 27 and NAD 83  
for 7.5-minute intersections are obtainable from National Geodetic  
Survey NADCON software.
