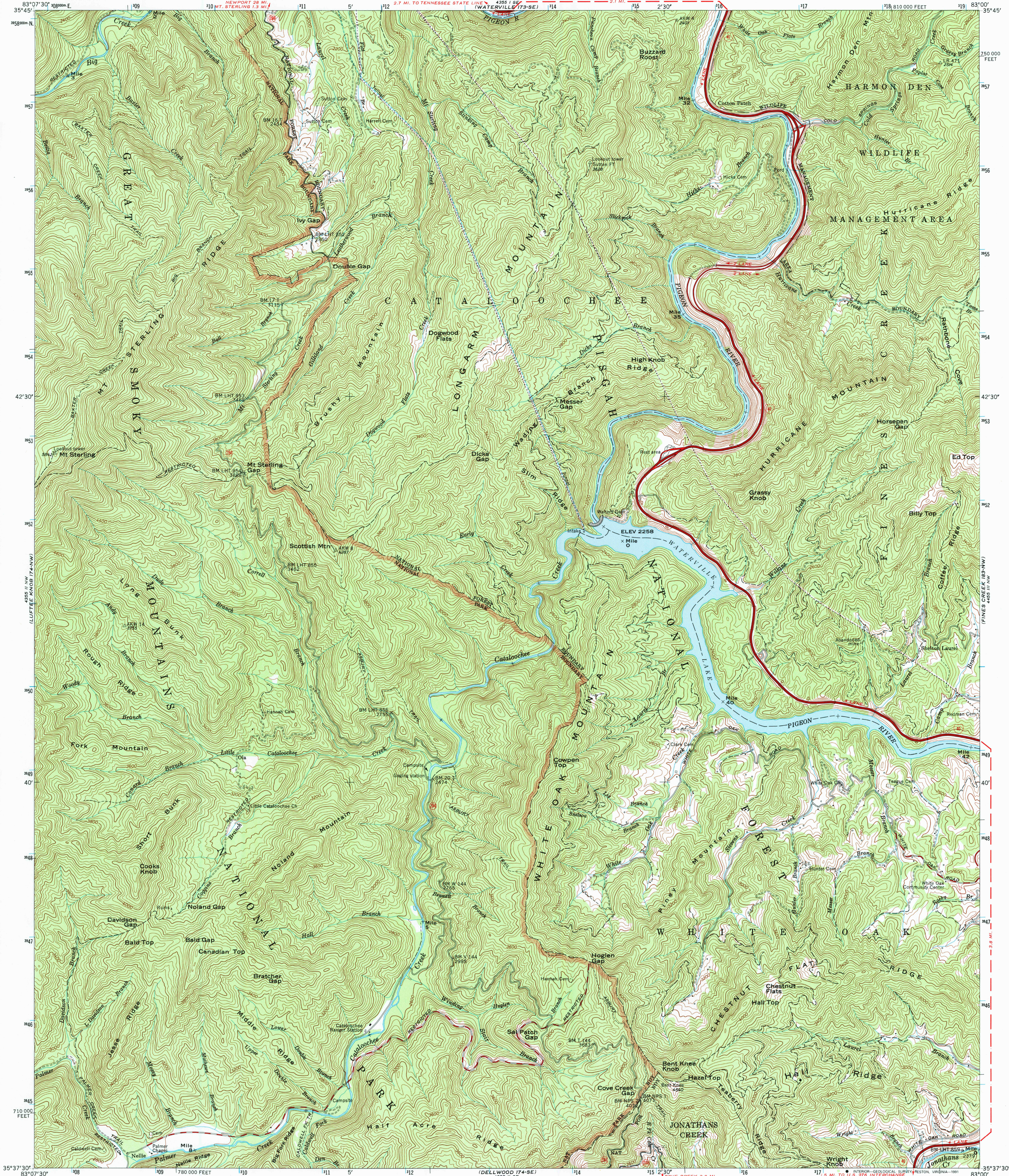

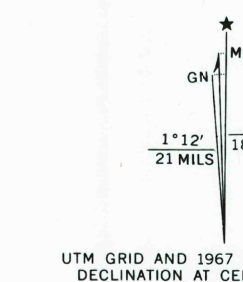

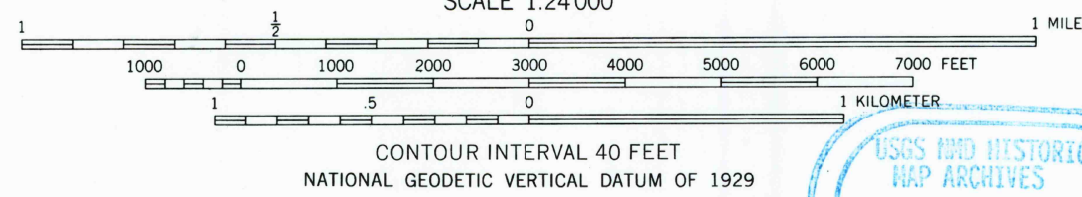
1000 meter Universal Transverse Mercator Grid ticks,

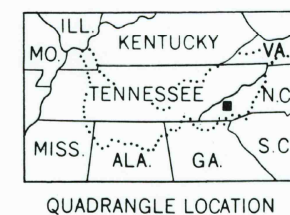
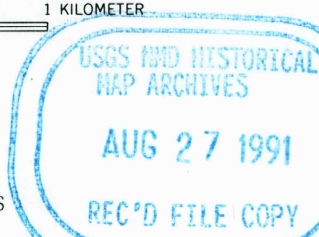


UTM GRID and 1967 MAGNETIC NORTH
