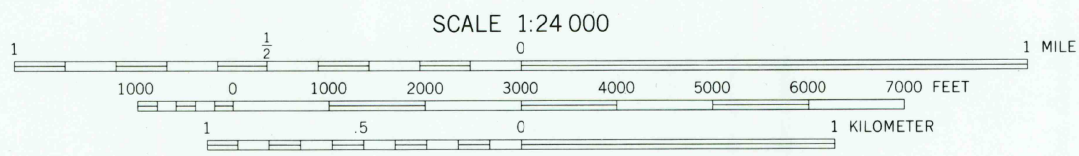
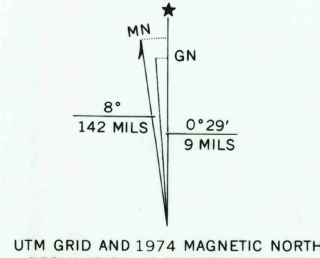

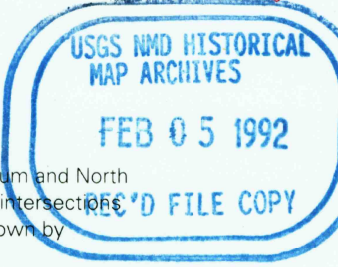


CONTOUR INTERVAL 5 FEET
