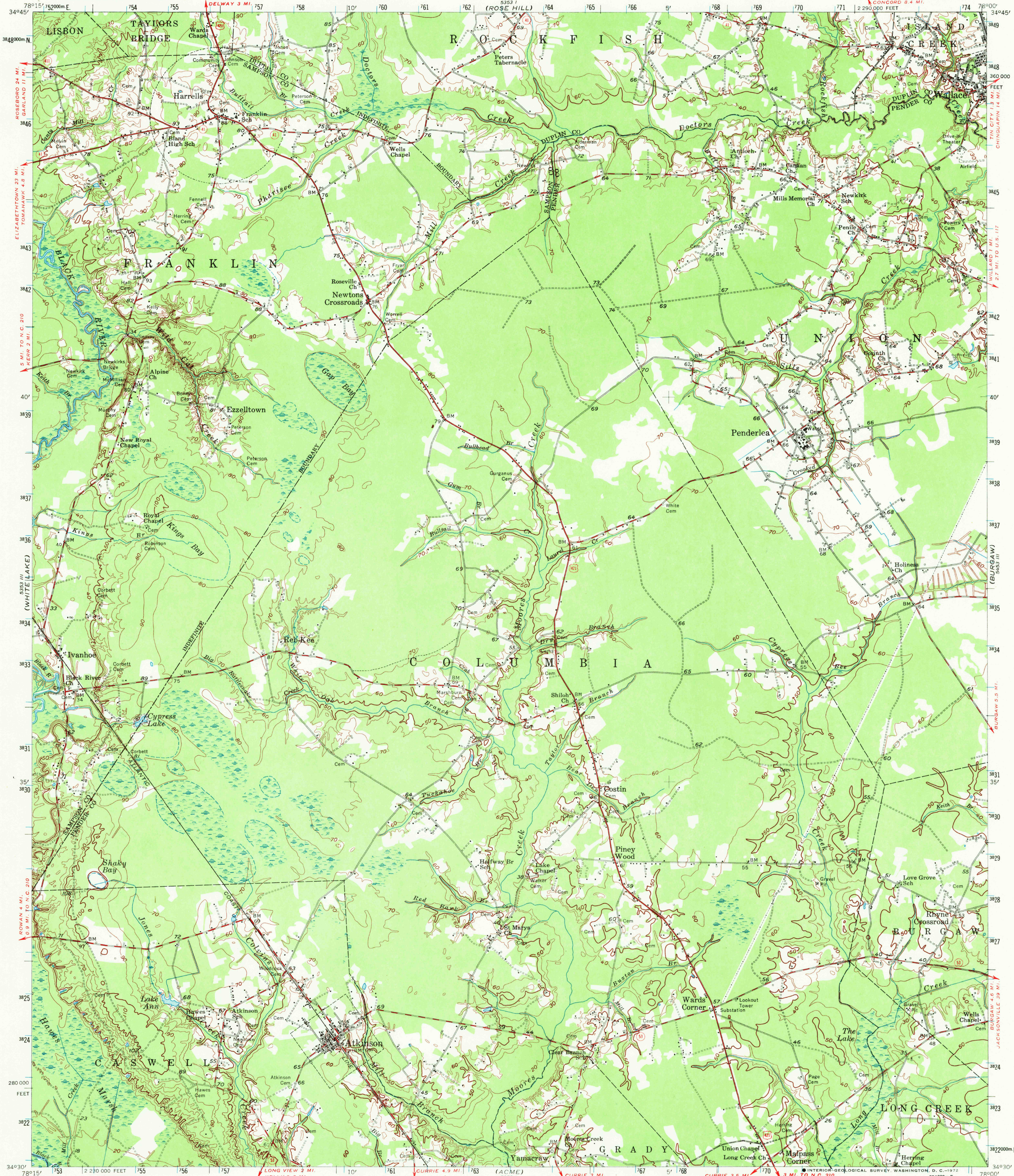

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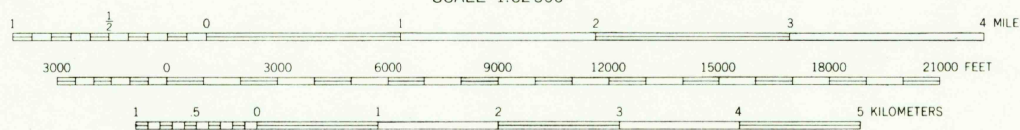
Culture and drainage in part compiled from aerial photographs taken 1951. Topography by planetable surveys 1954-1955
