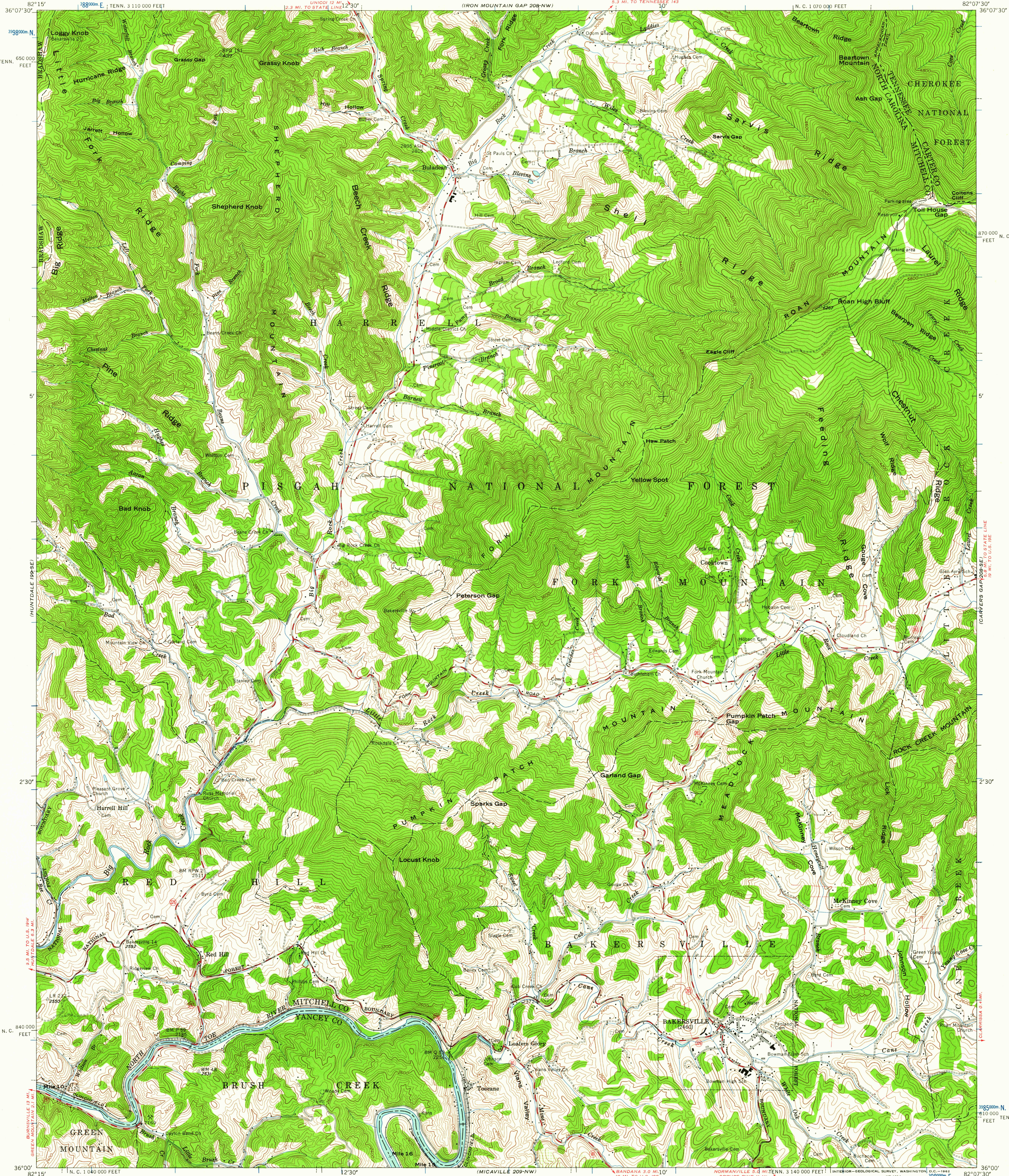

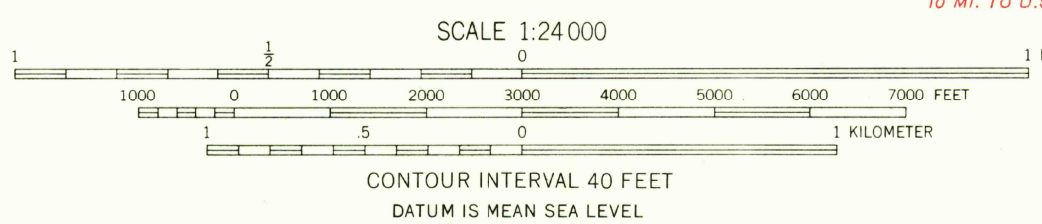

Zone 17, shown in blue

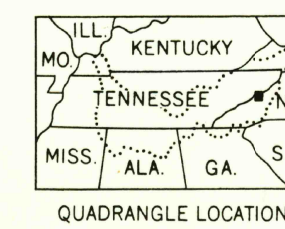
