

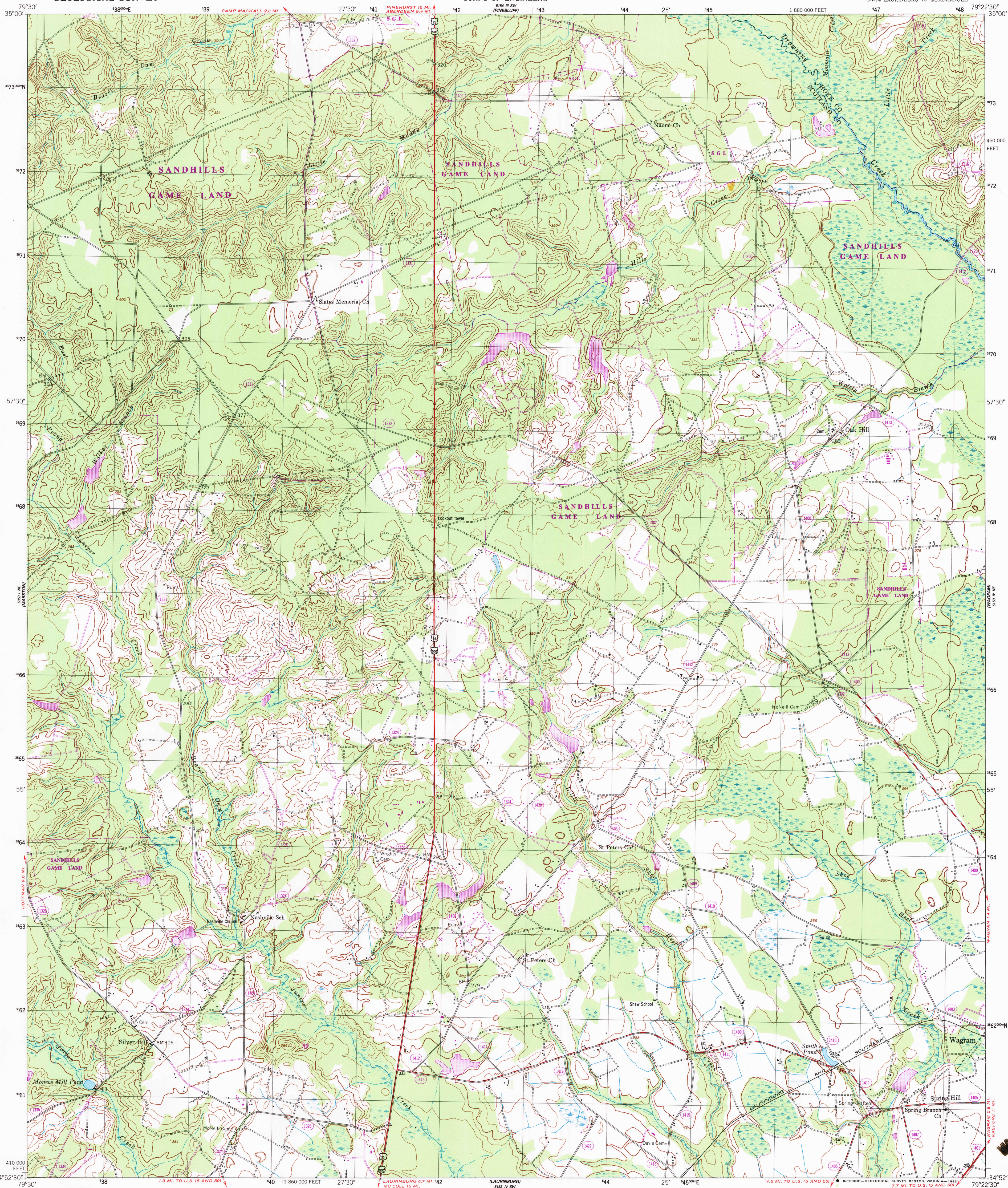

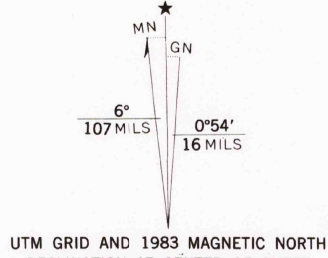
SILVER HILL QUADRANGLE
