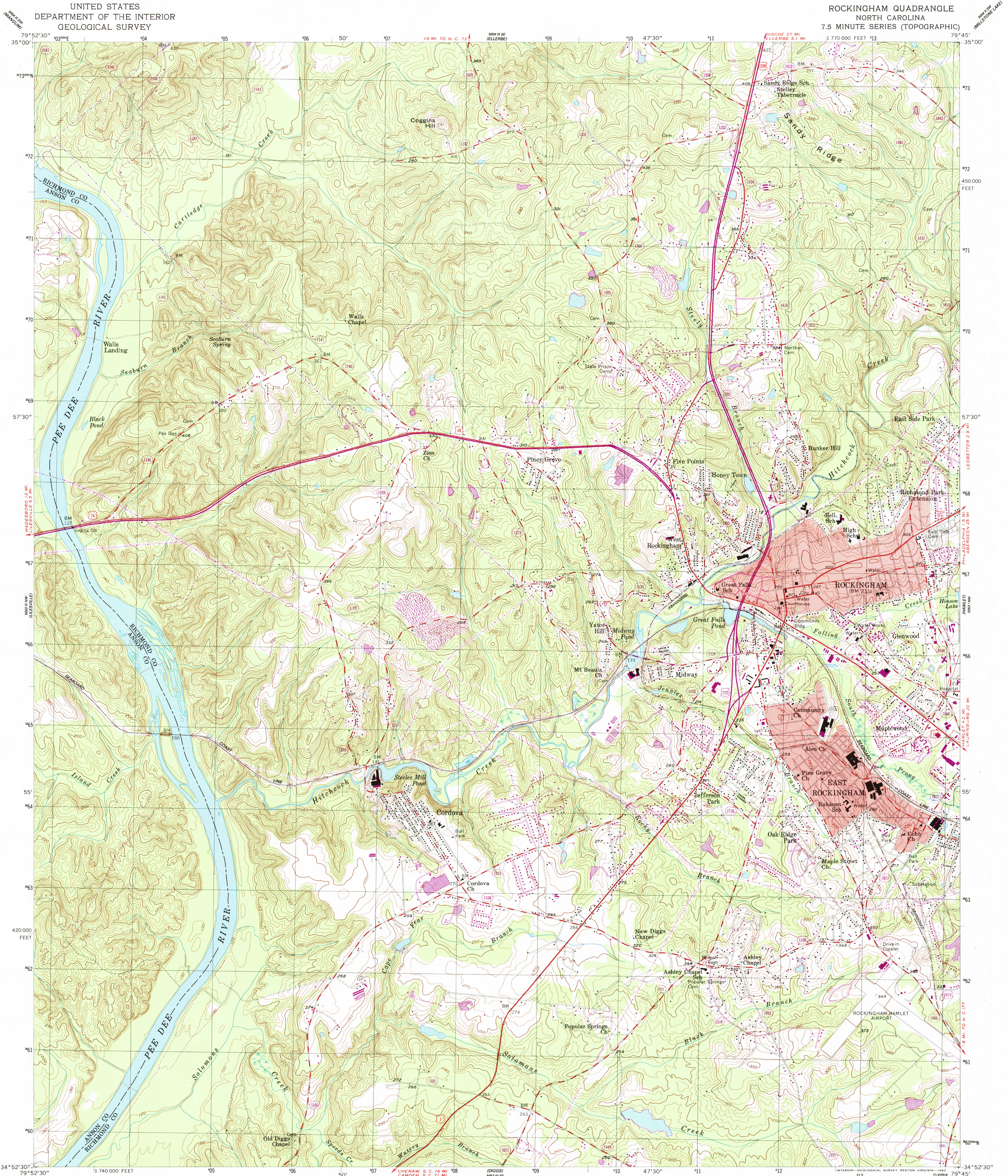




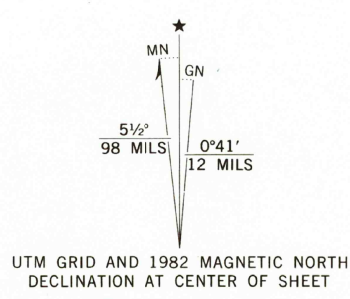

dashed corner ticks

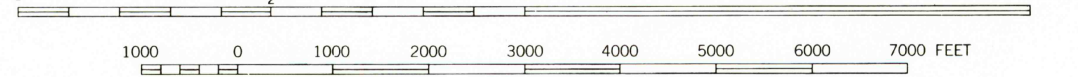
