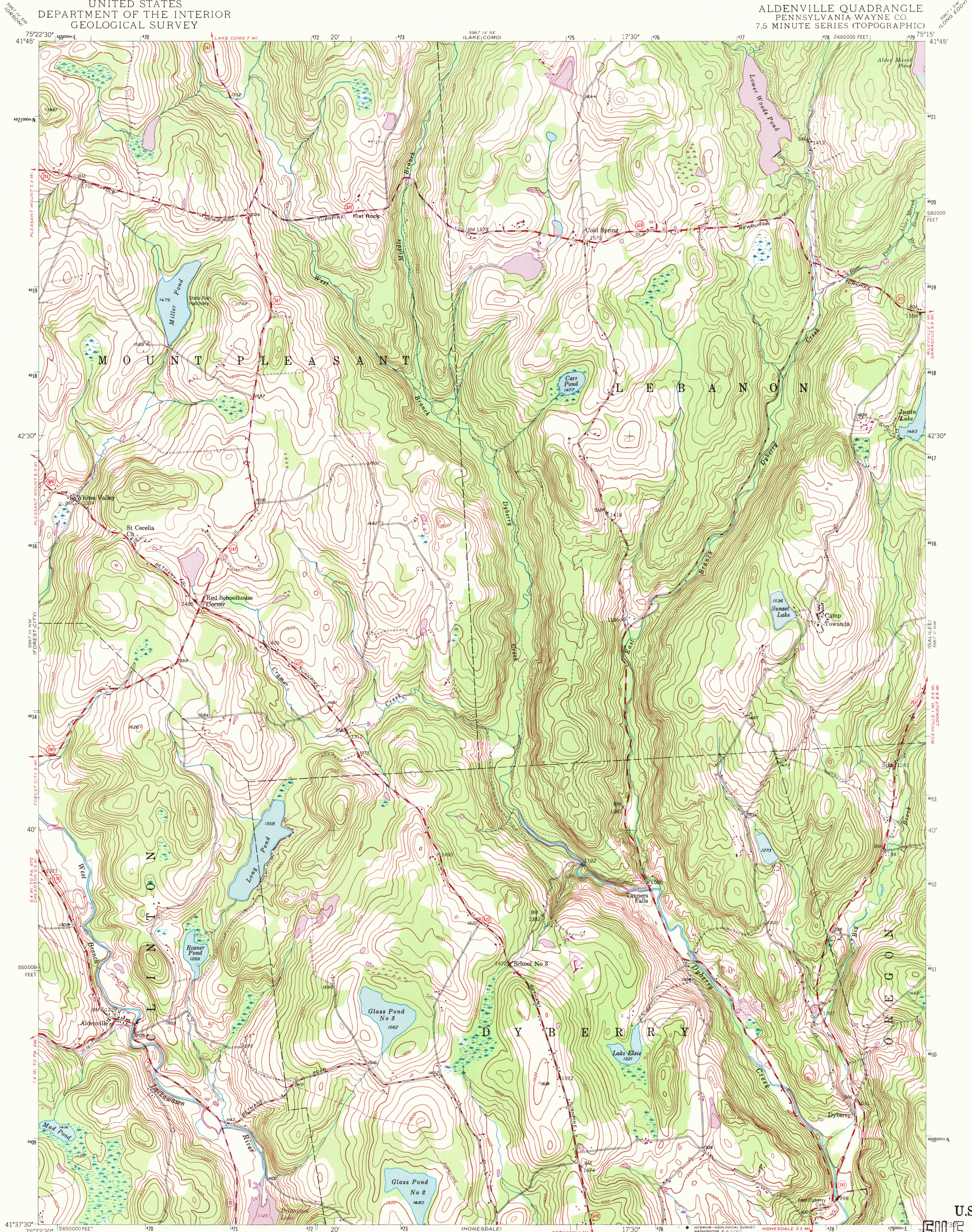

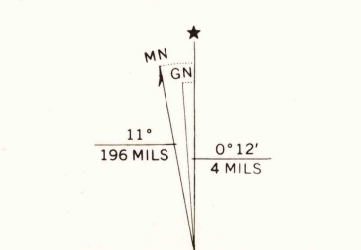

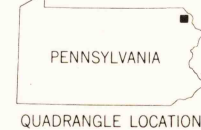
Prompton Lake is subject to controlled
