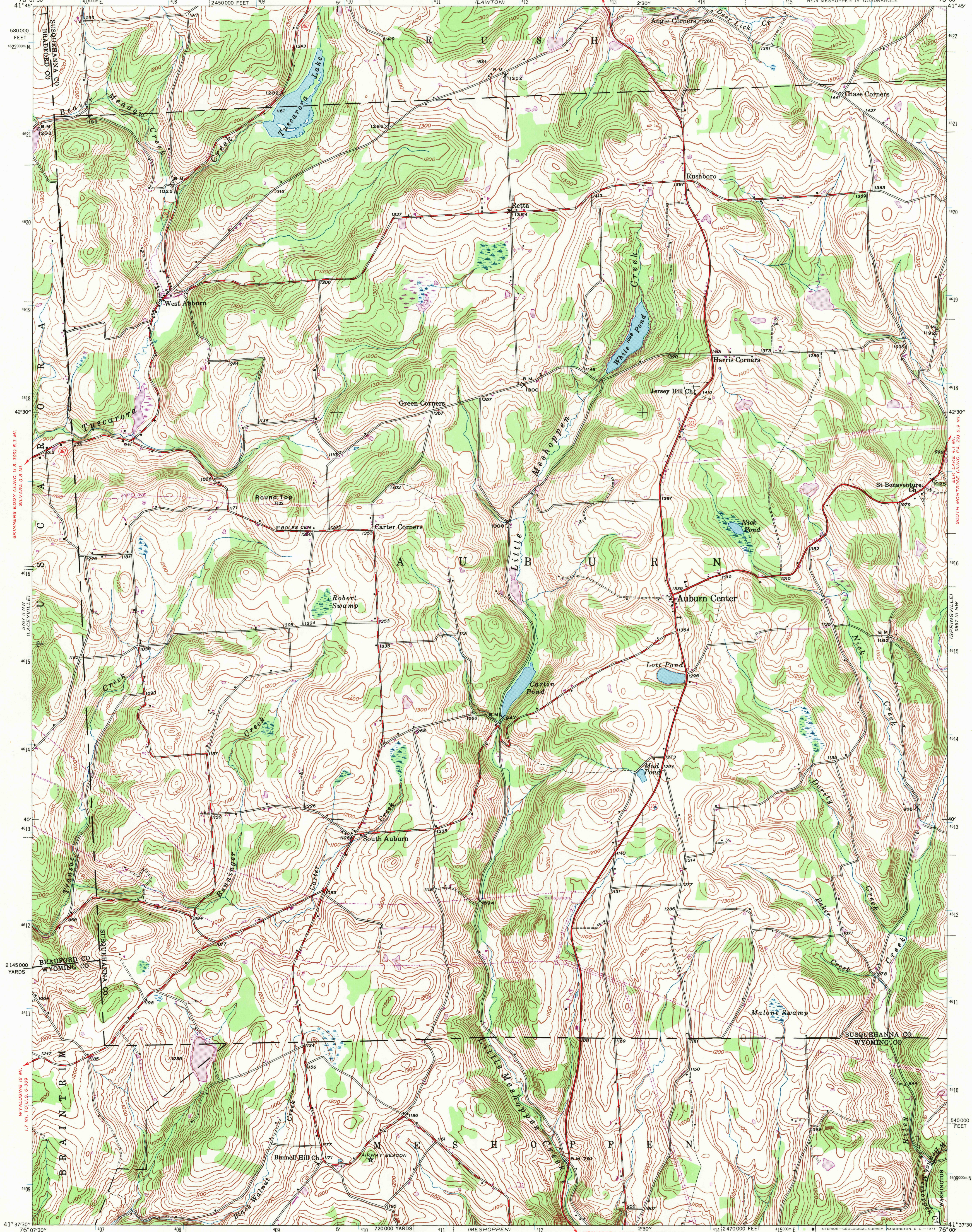

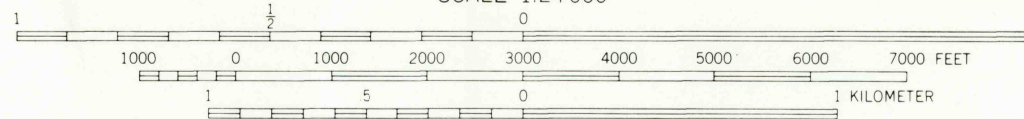
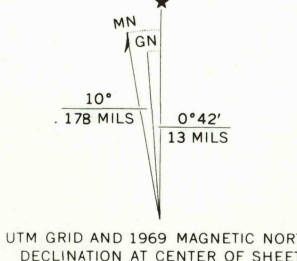
PENNSYLVANIA

NE/4 MESHOPPEN 15' QUADRANGLE



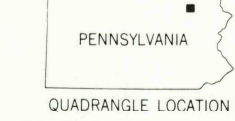
