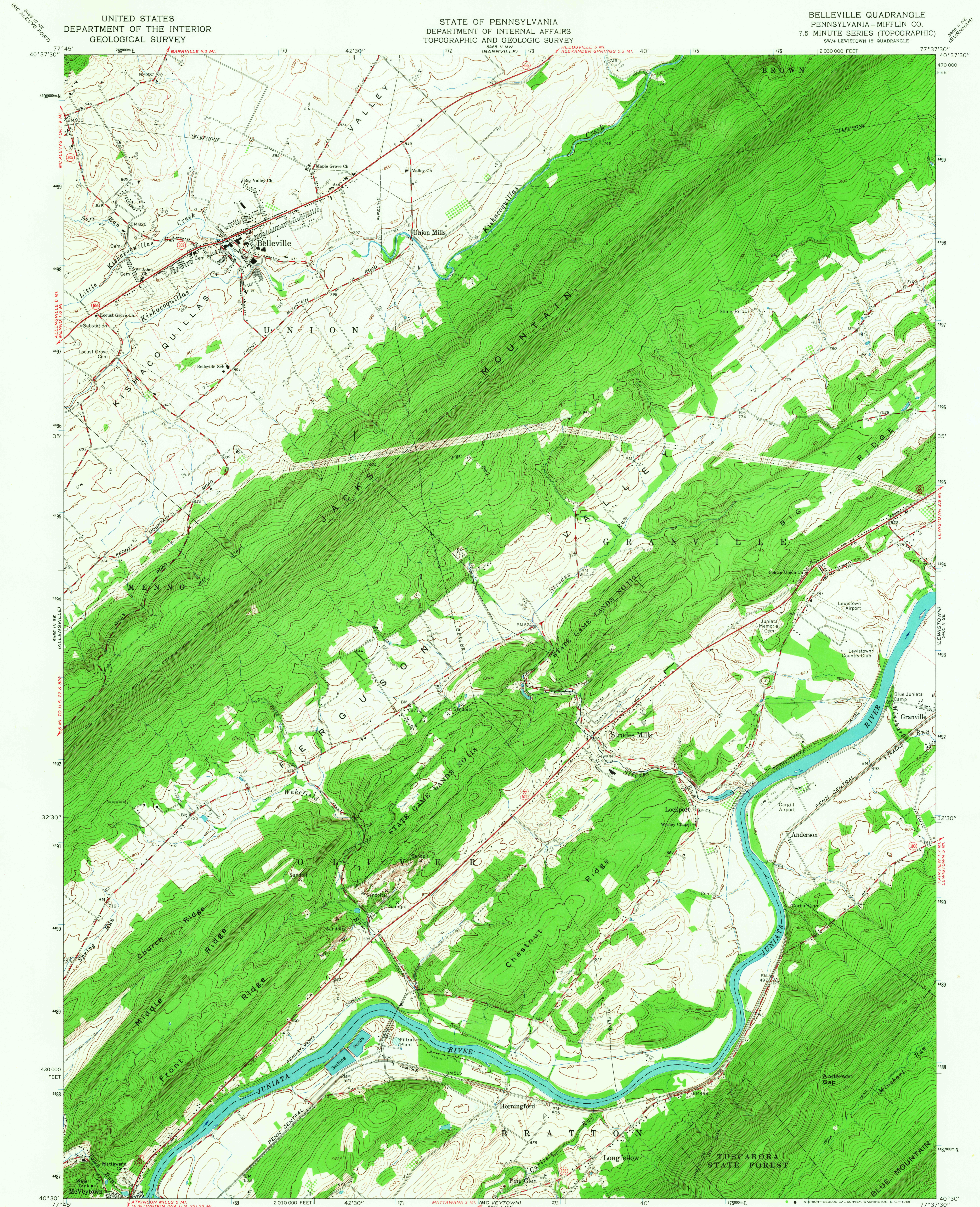




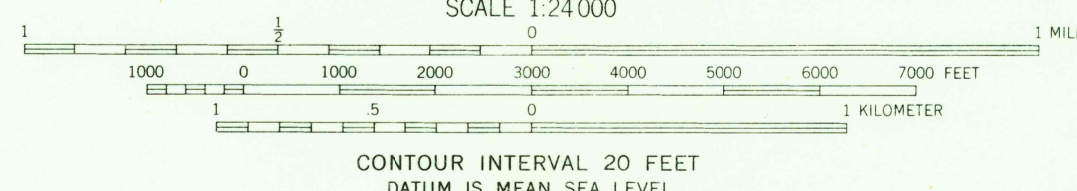
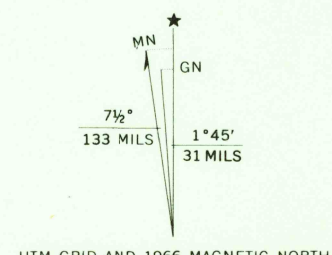

south zone

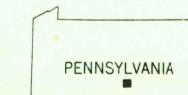
1000 meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
