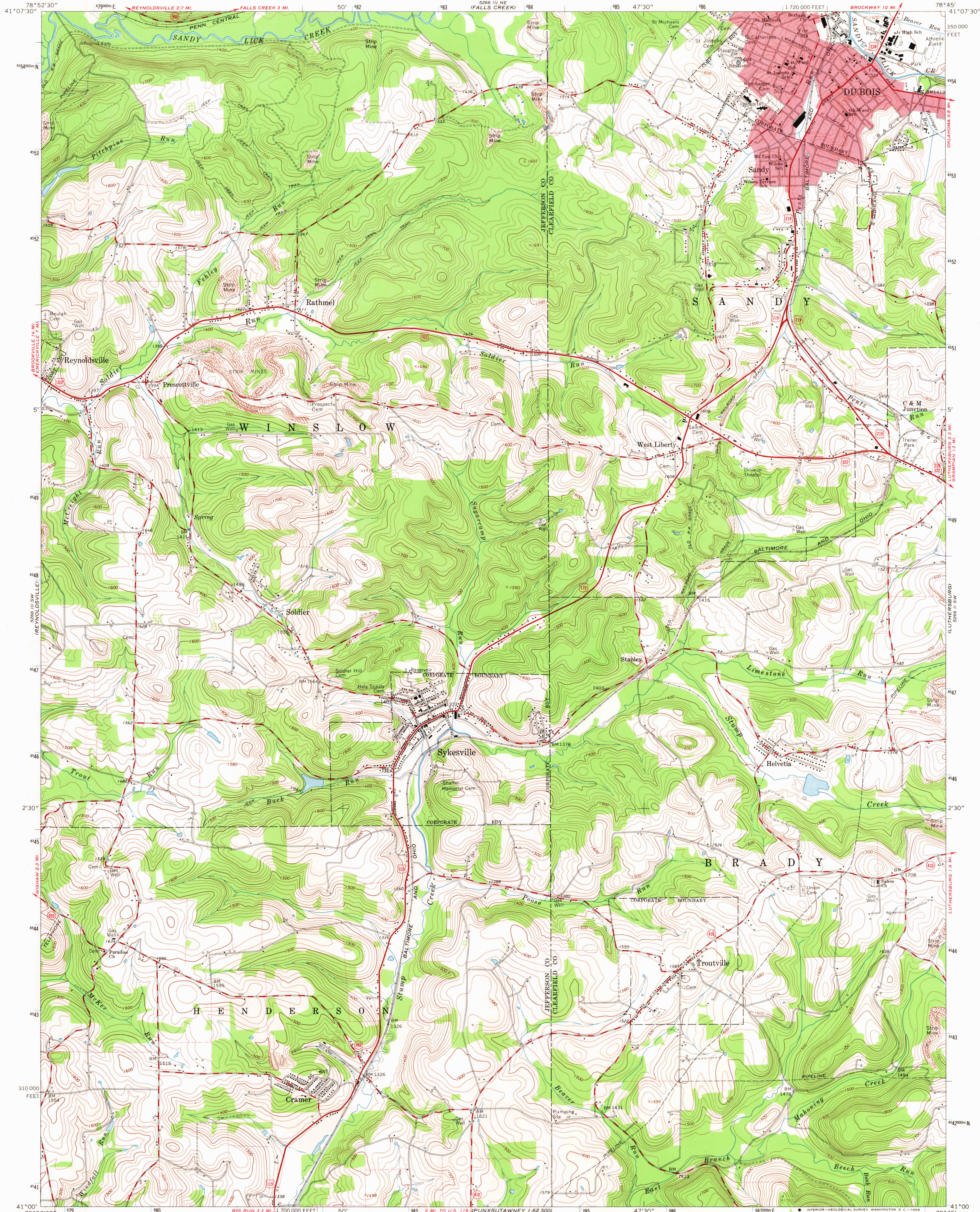


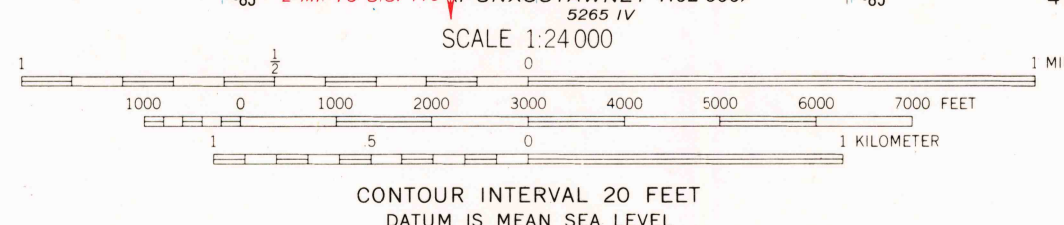

SE/4 DU BOIS 15' QUADRANGLE

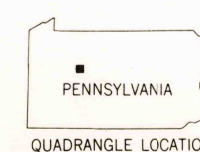
