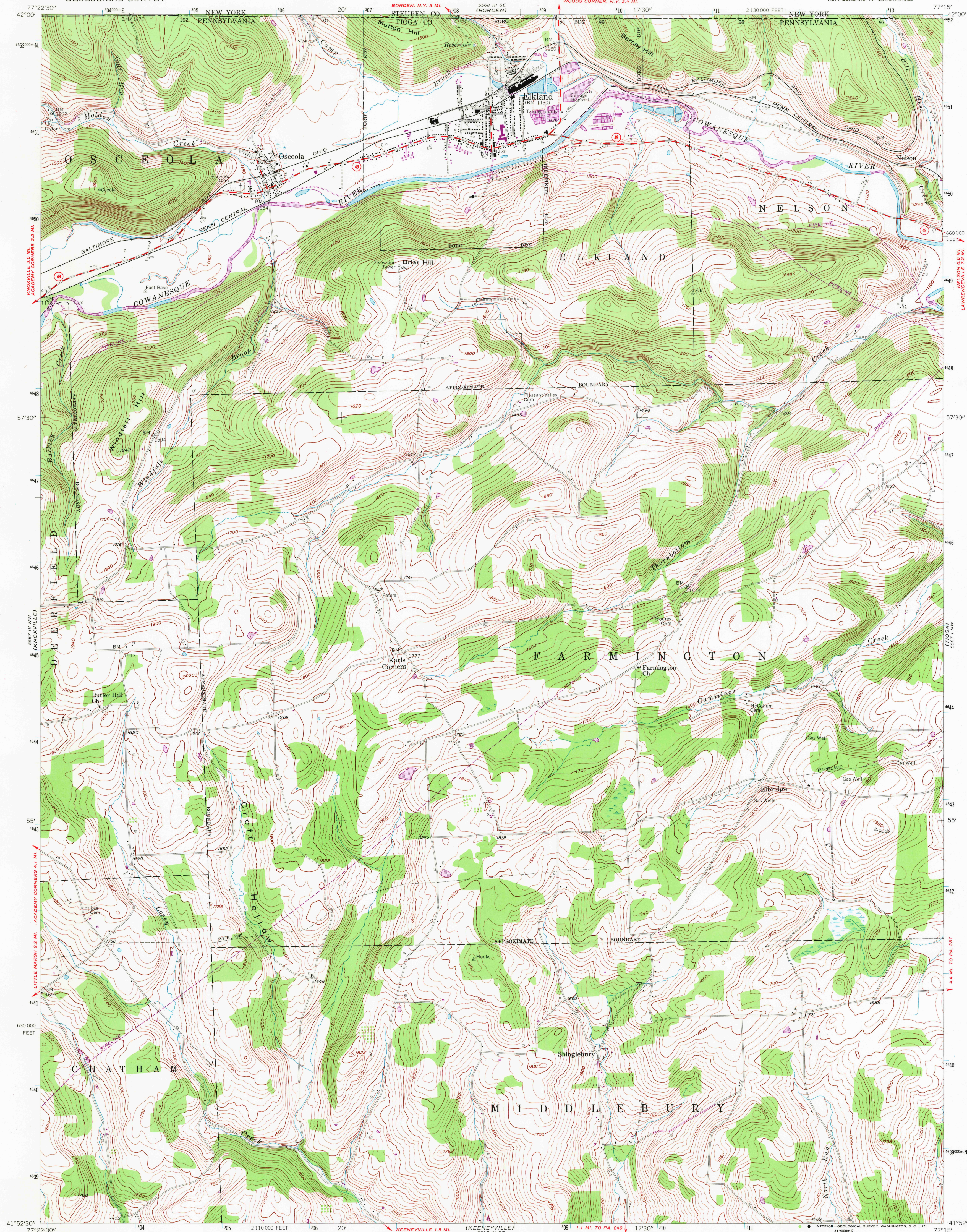

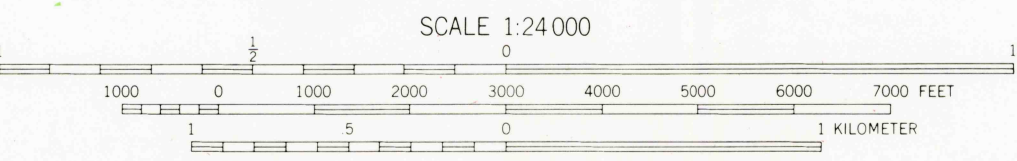
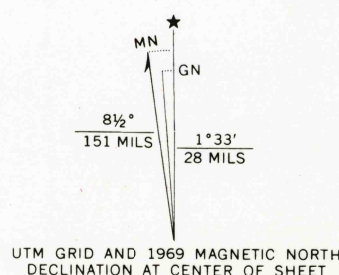

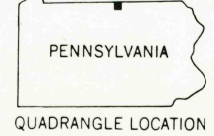
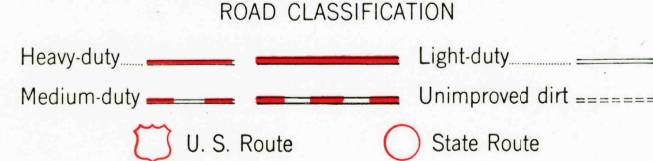
Unchecked elevations are shown in brown. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 18, shown in blue.
