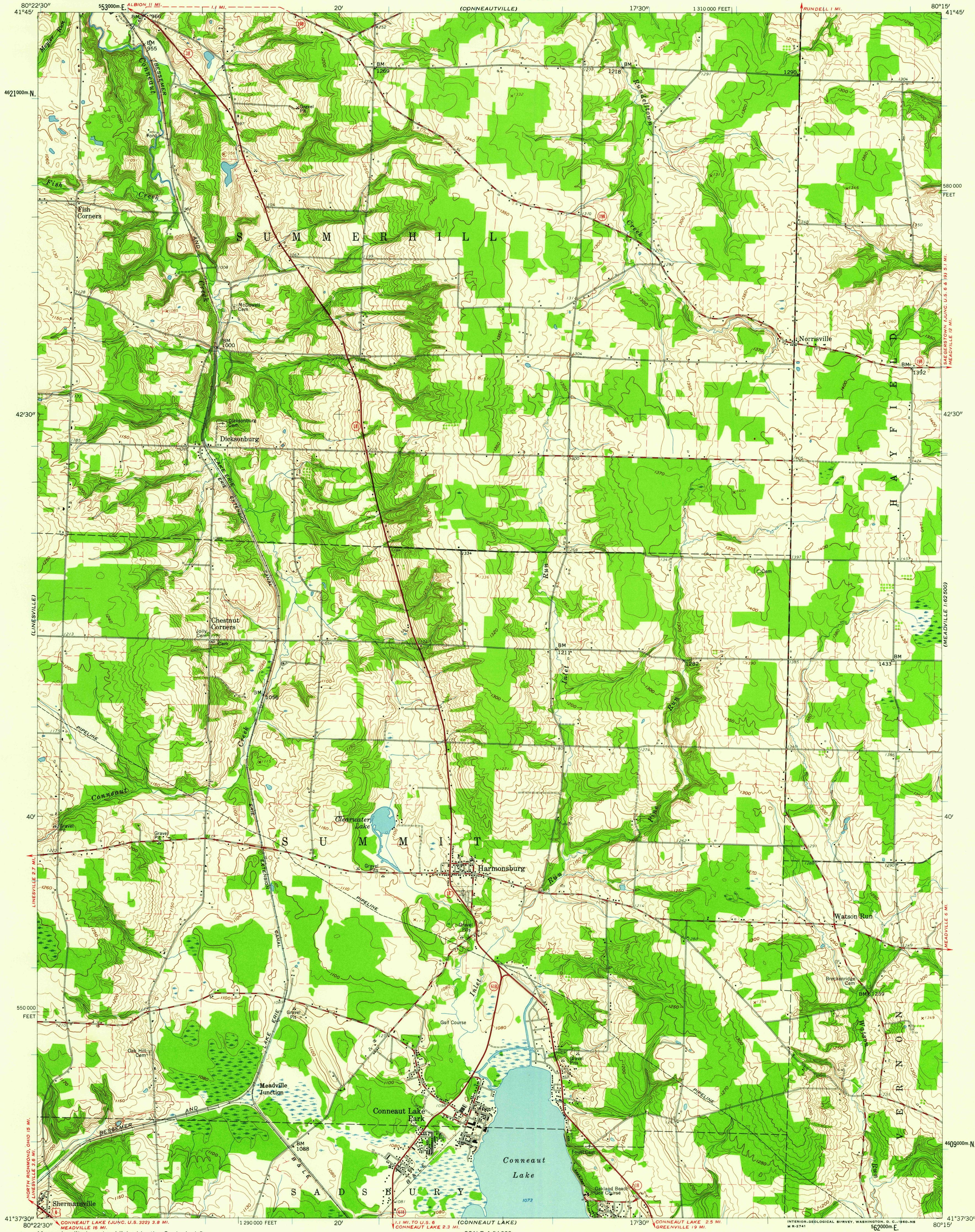

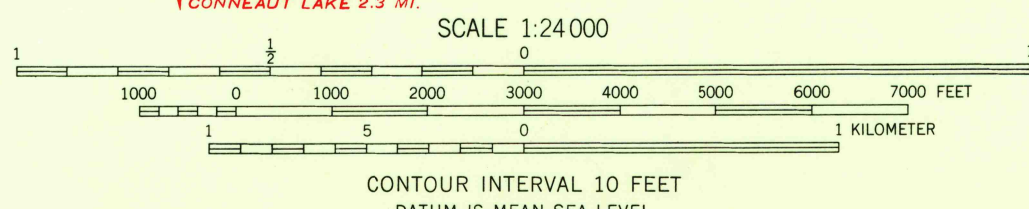
HARMONSBURG QUADRANGLE

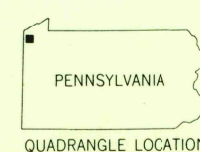
