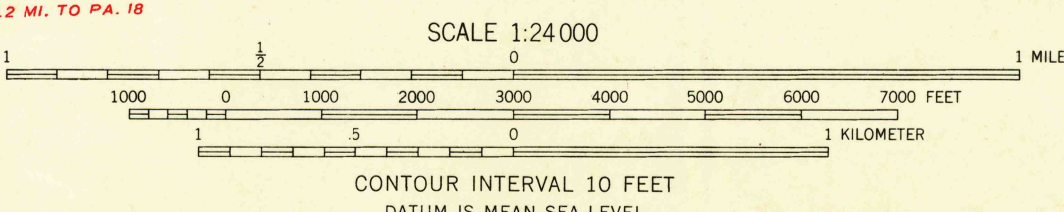

NE 1/4 NESHANNOCK 15' QUADRANGLE

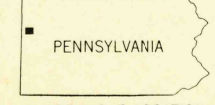
