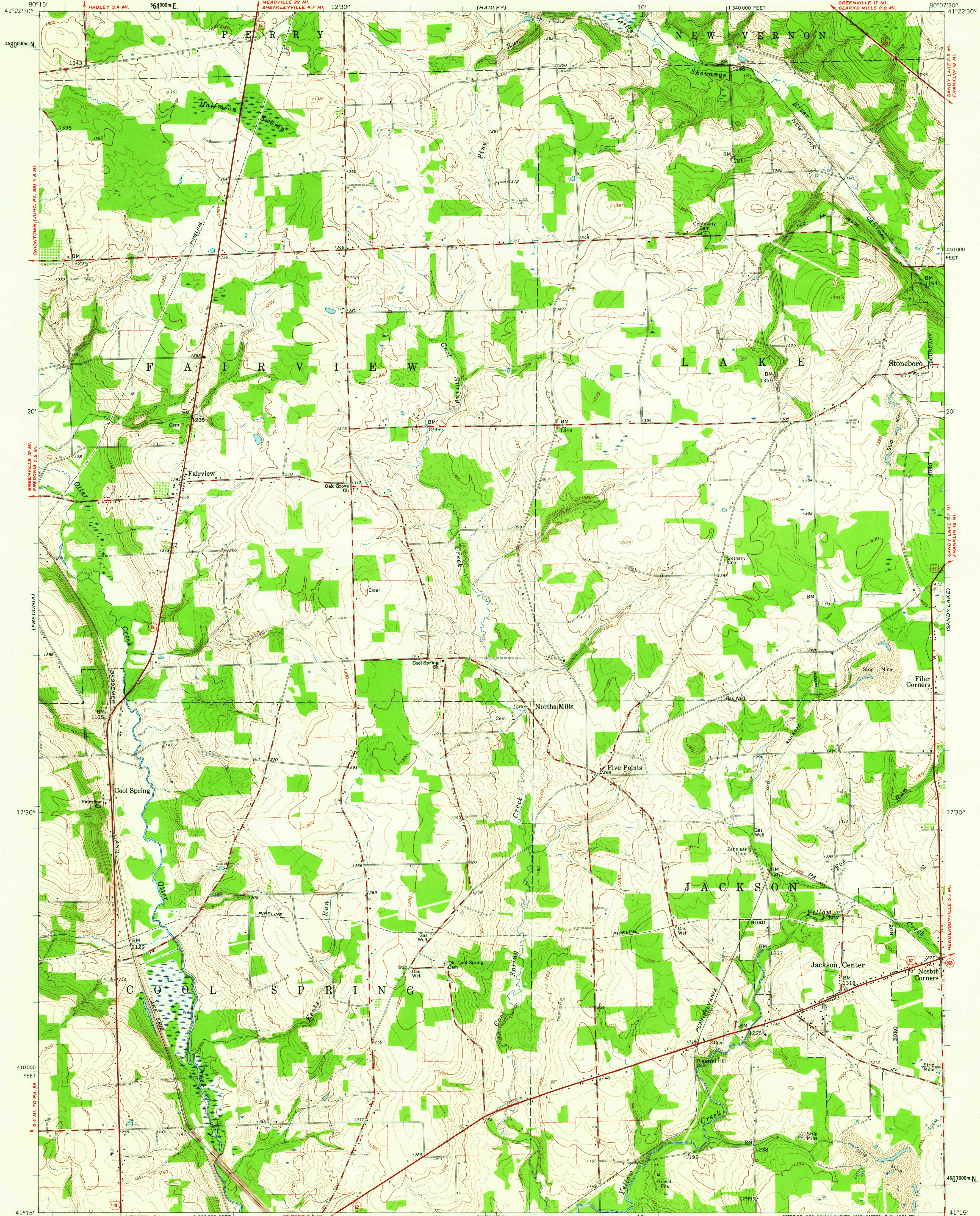

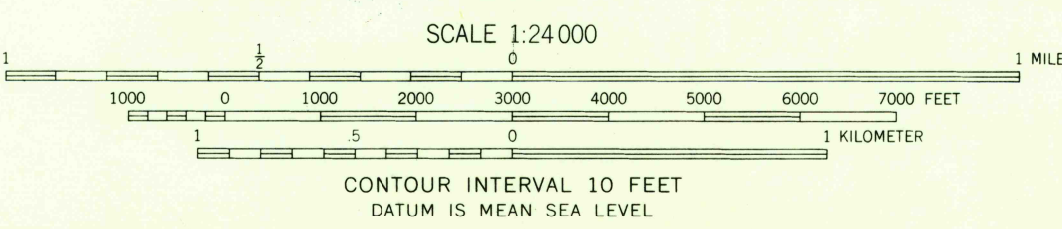
SW 1/4 STONEBORO 15' QUADRANGLE
