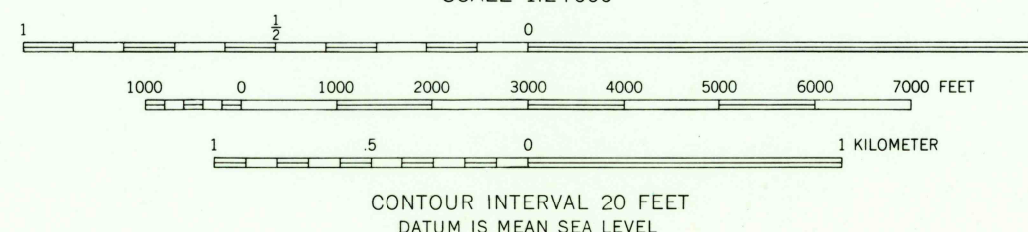
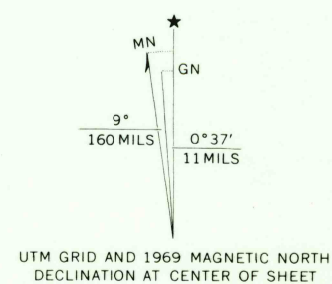

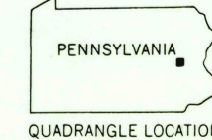
NEW RINGGOLD QUADRANGLE
