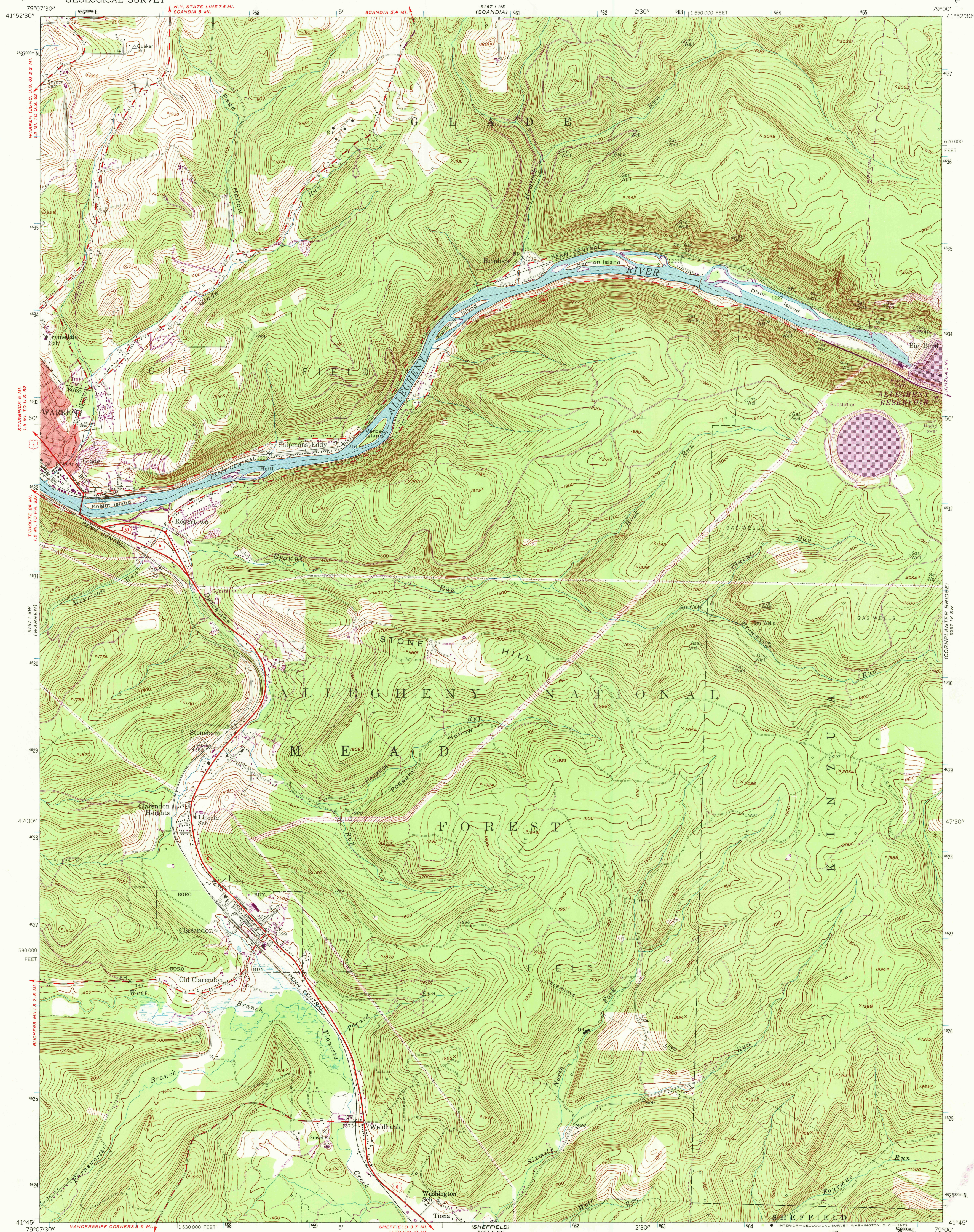

north zone

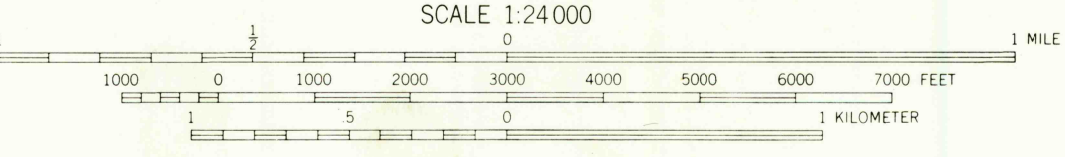
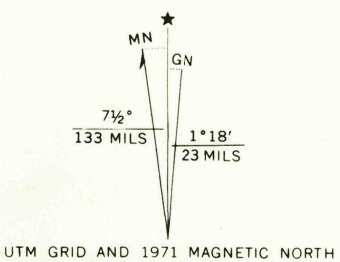
Red tint indicates area in which only

Oil and gas wells omitted in labeled oil field areas

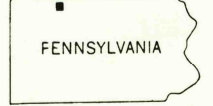
Unchecked elevations are shown in brown
