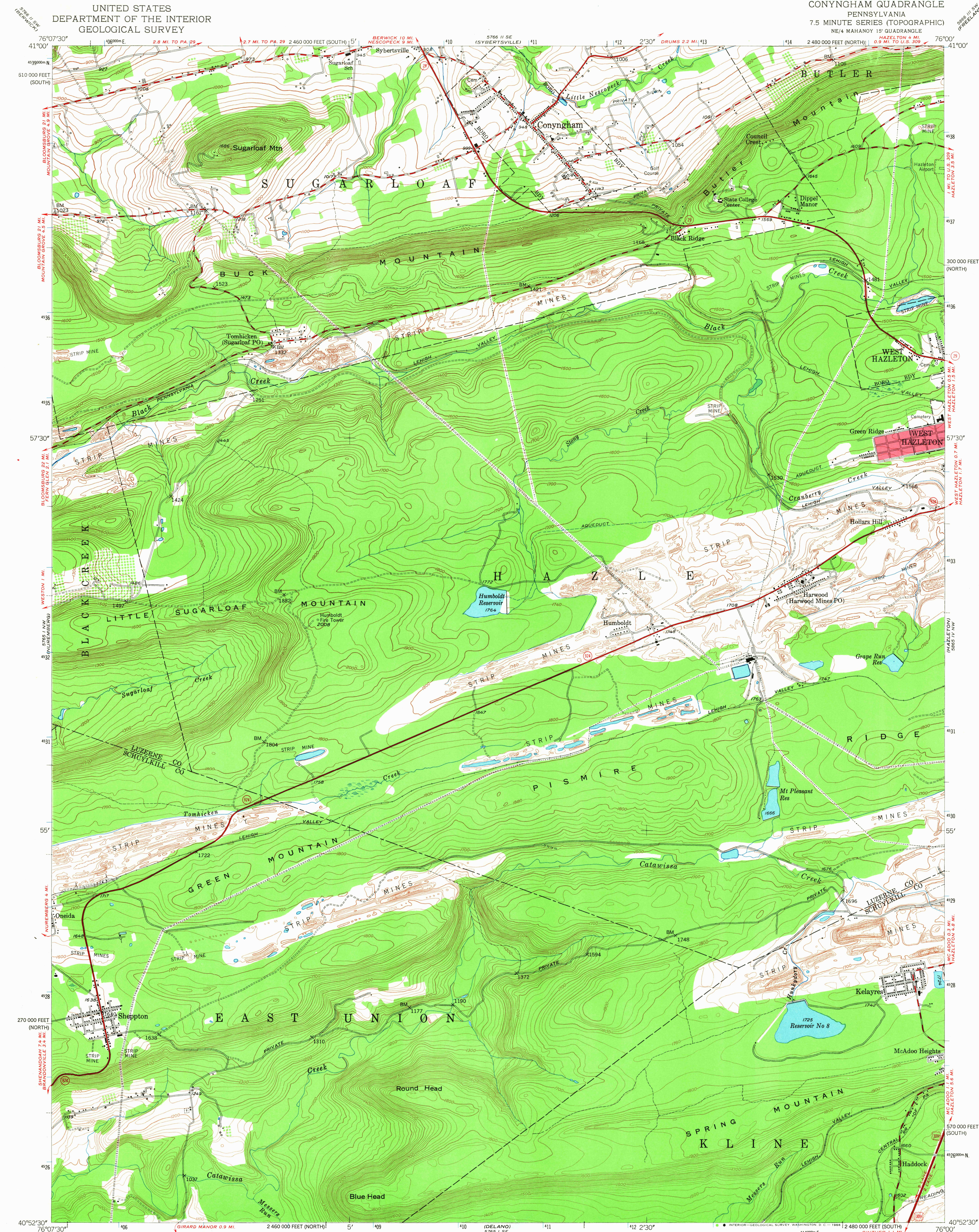

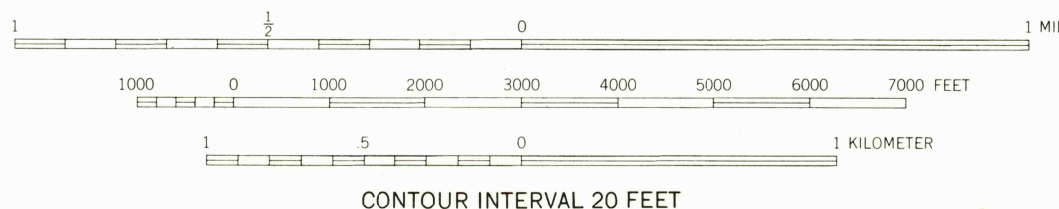
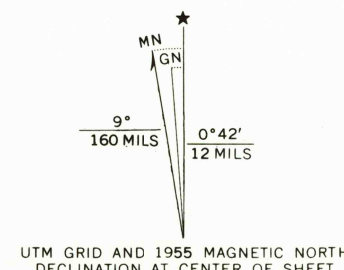

landmark buildings are shown

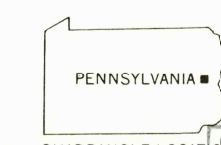
Contours in strip mine areas compiled from 1942 photography
