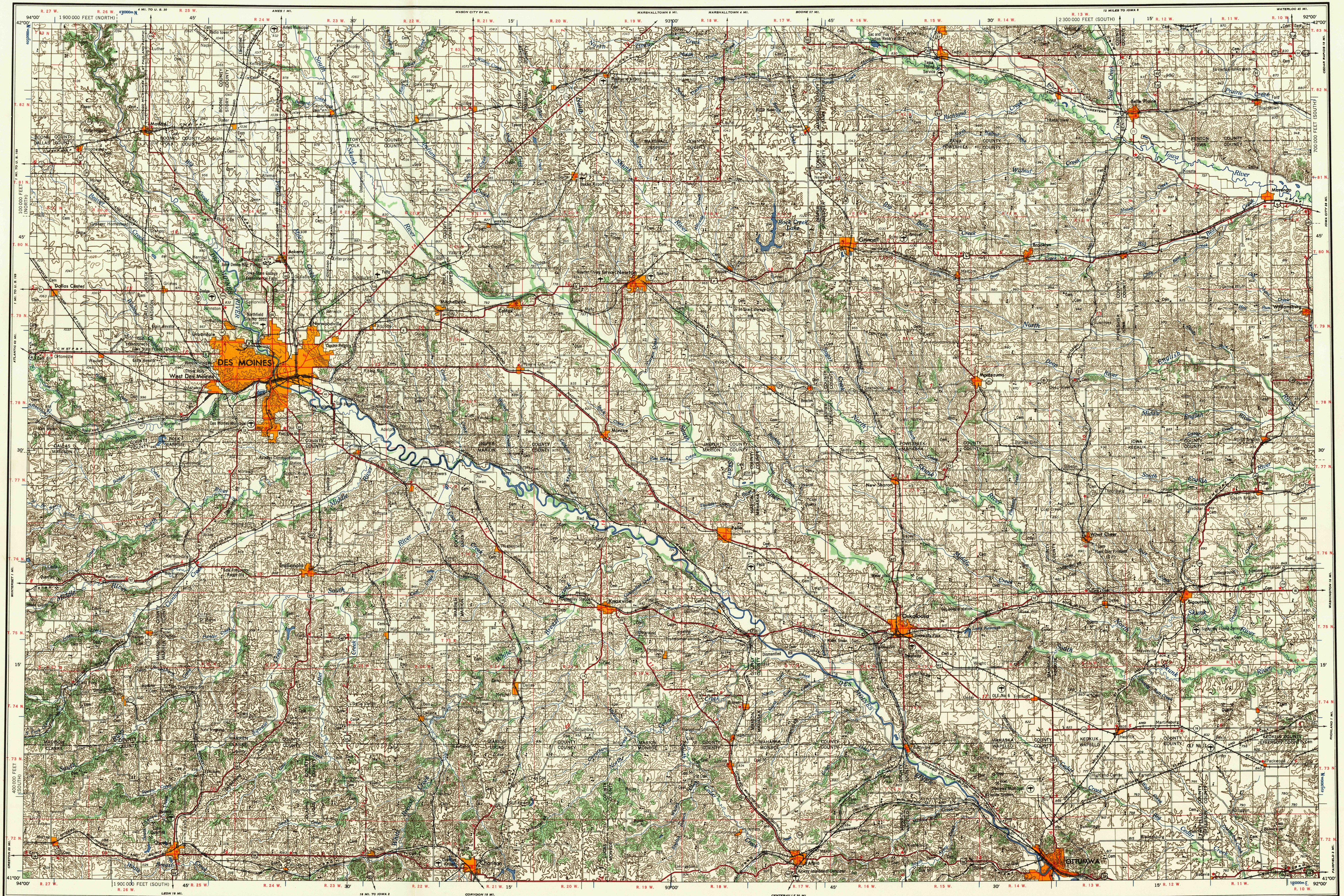
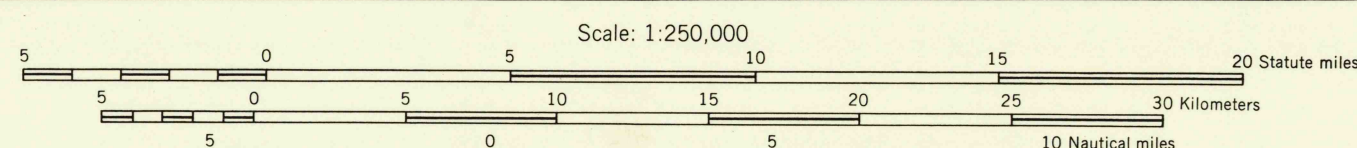
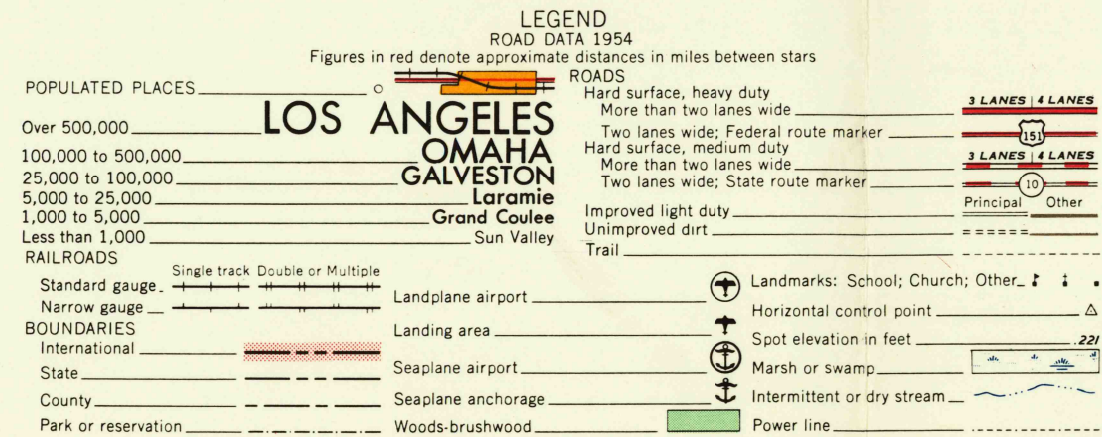

10,000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue

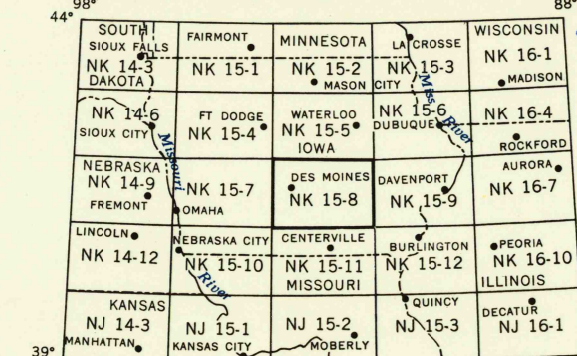


CONTOUR INTERVAL 50 FEET
