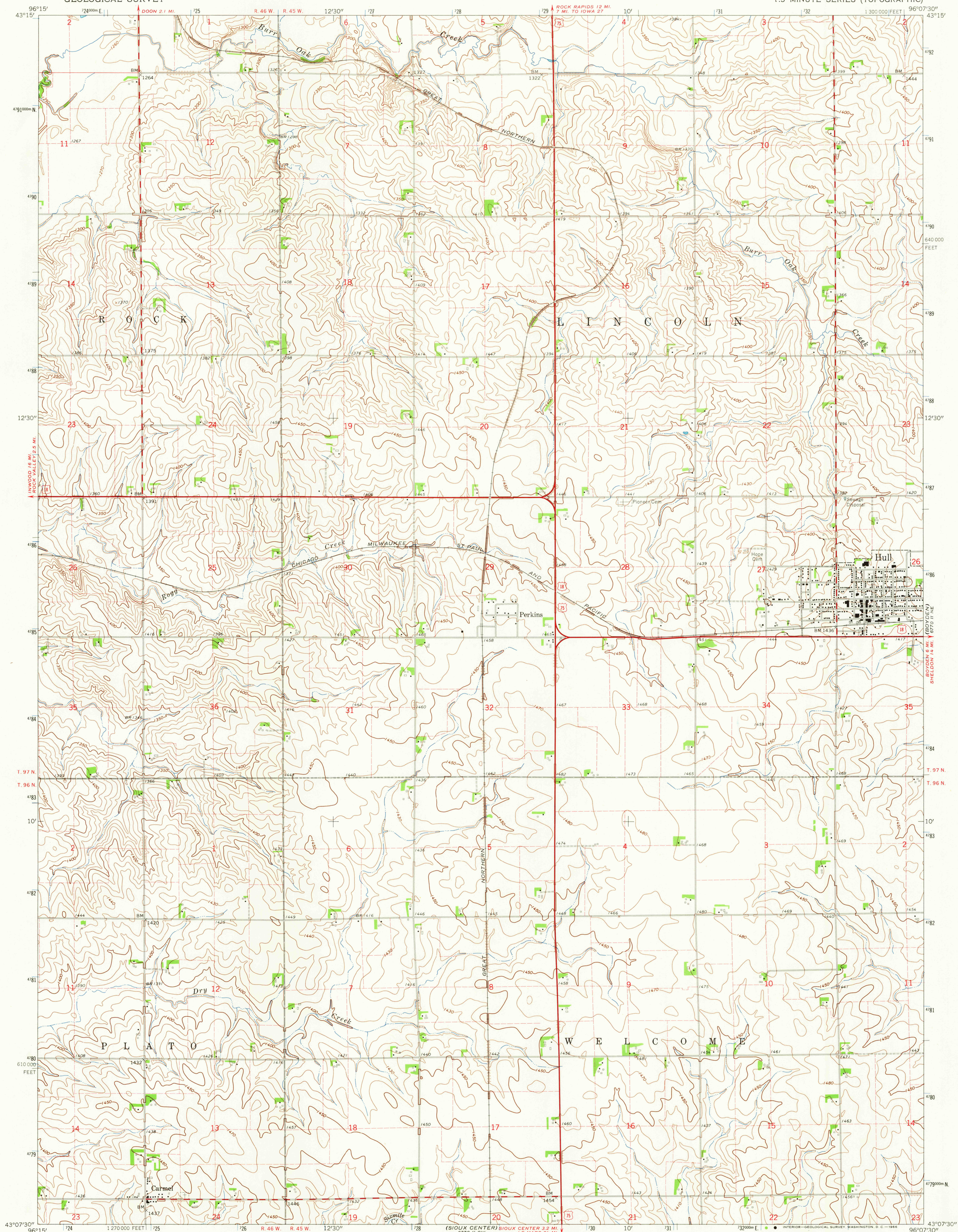

10,000-foot grid based on Iowa coordinate system, north zone

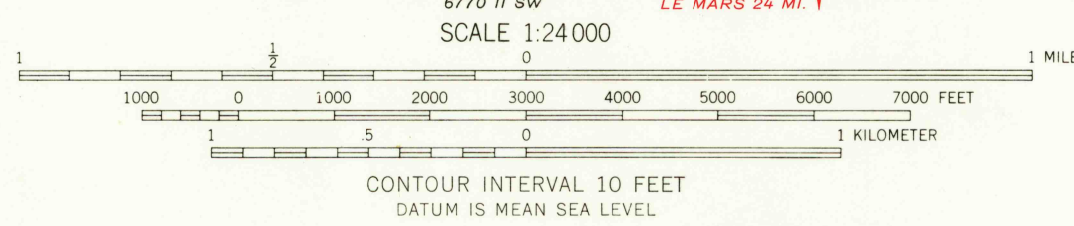
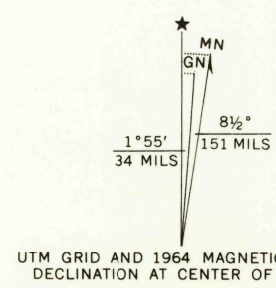
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where

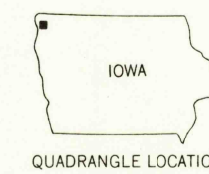
