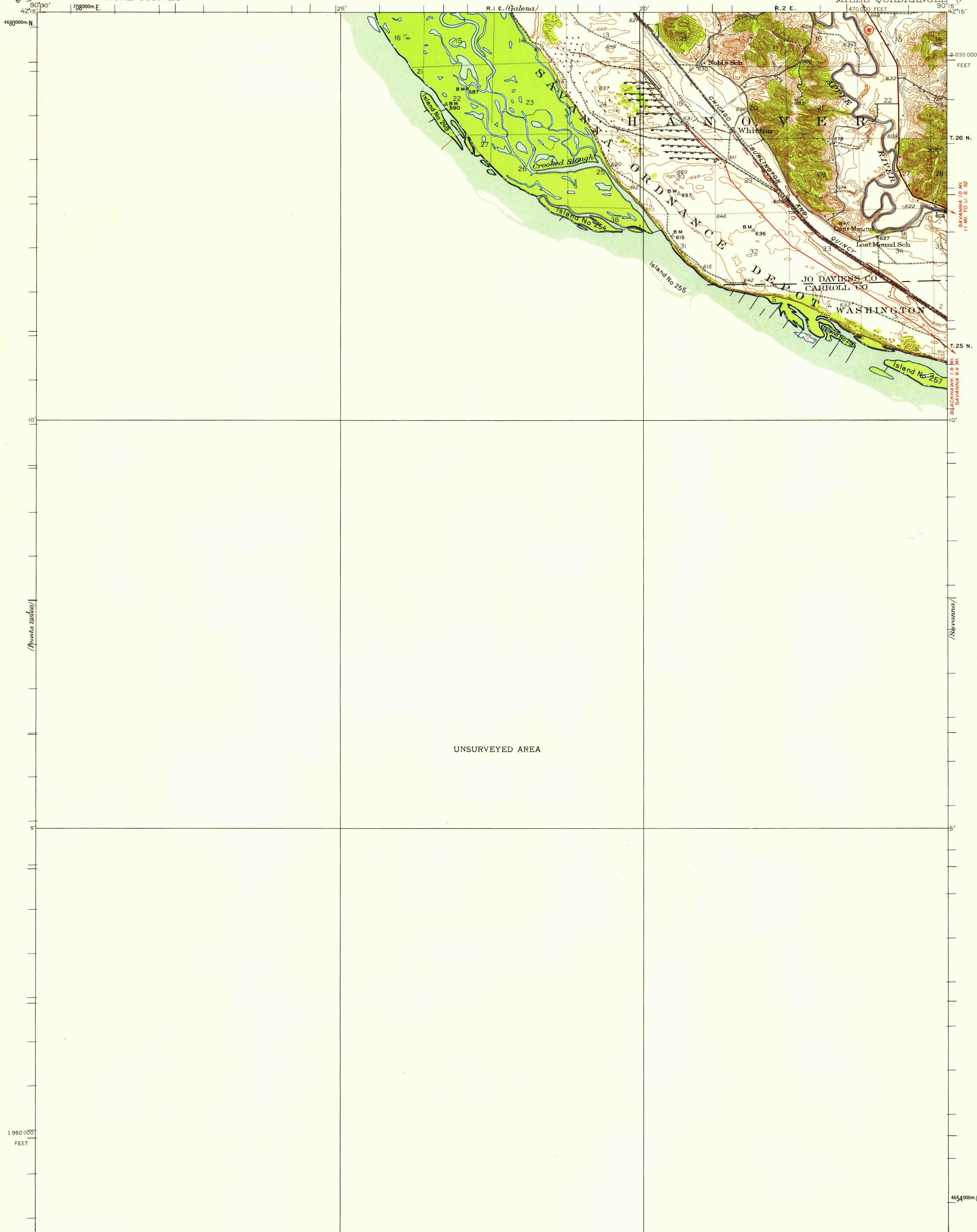

MILES QUADRANGLE



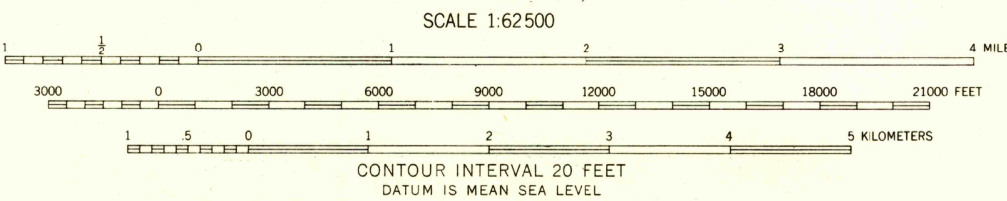
