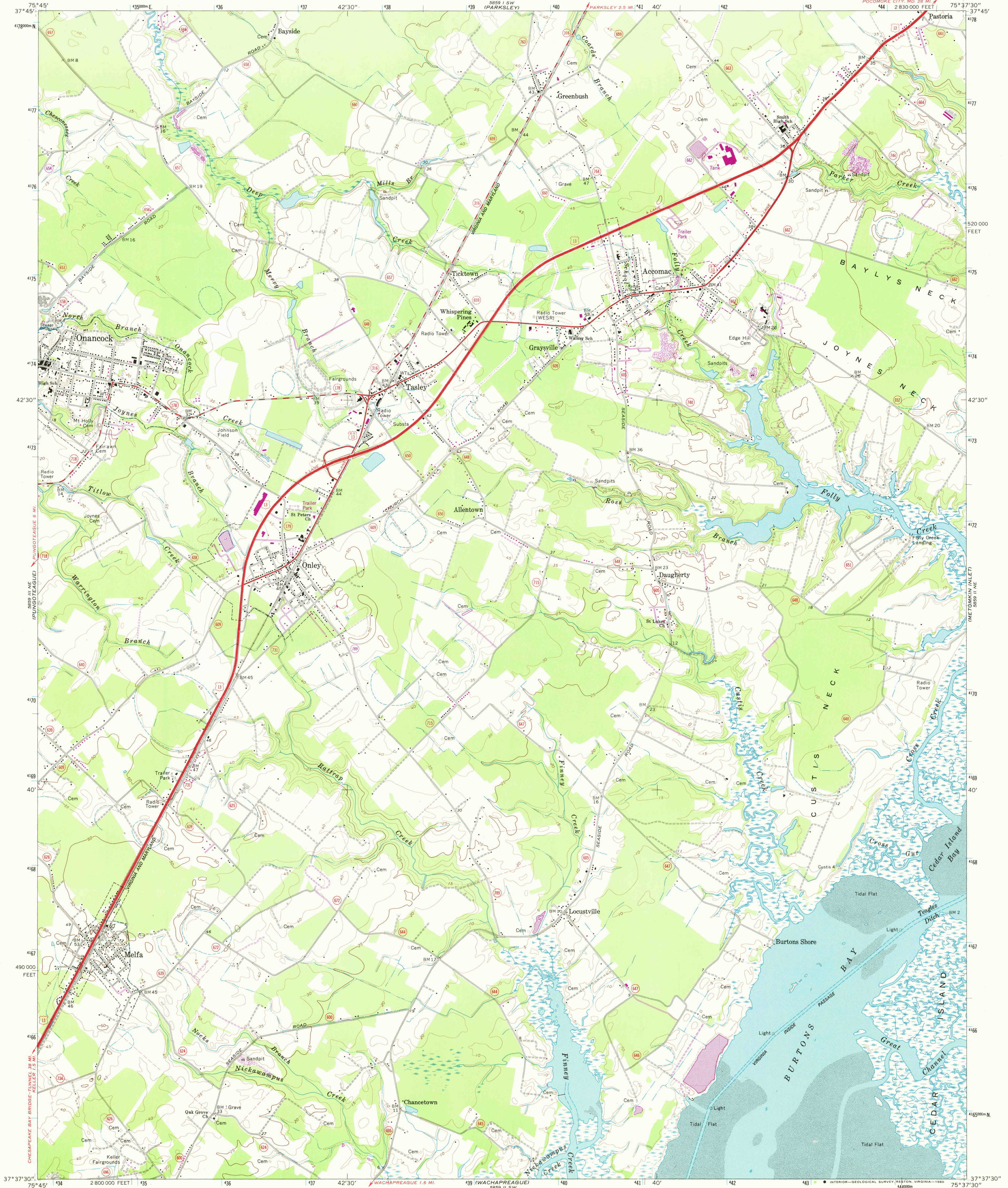
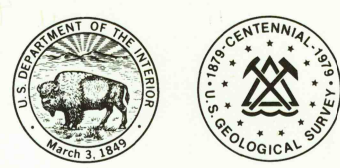

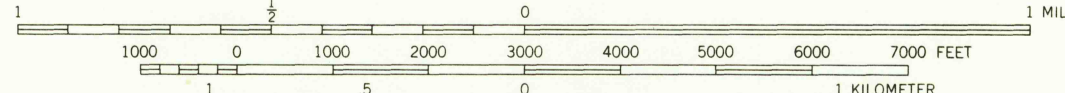

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Virginia coordinate system, south zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 18, shown in blue.

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 9 meters south and 31 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.

Revisions shown in purple compiled in cooperation with State of Virginia agencies from aerial photographs taken 1977 and other source data. This information not field checked. Map edited 1979.
