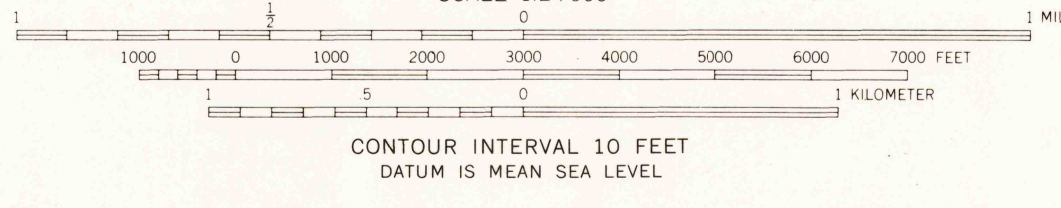

NW 1/4 BERRYVILLE 15' QUADRANGLE

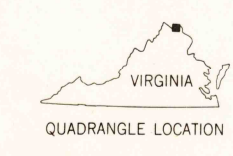
