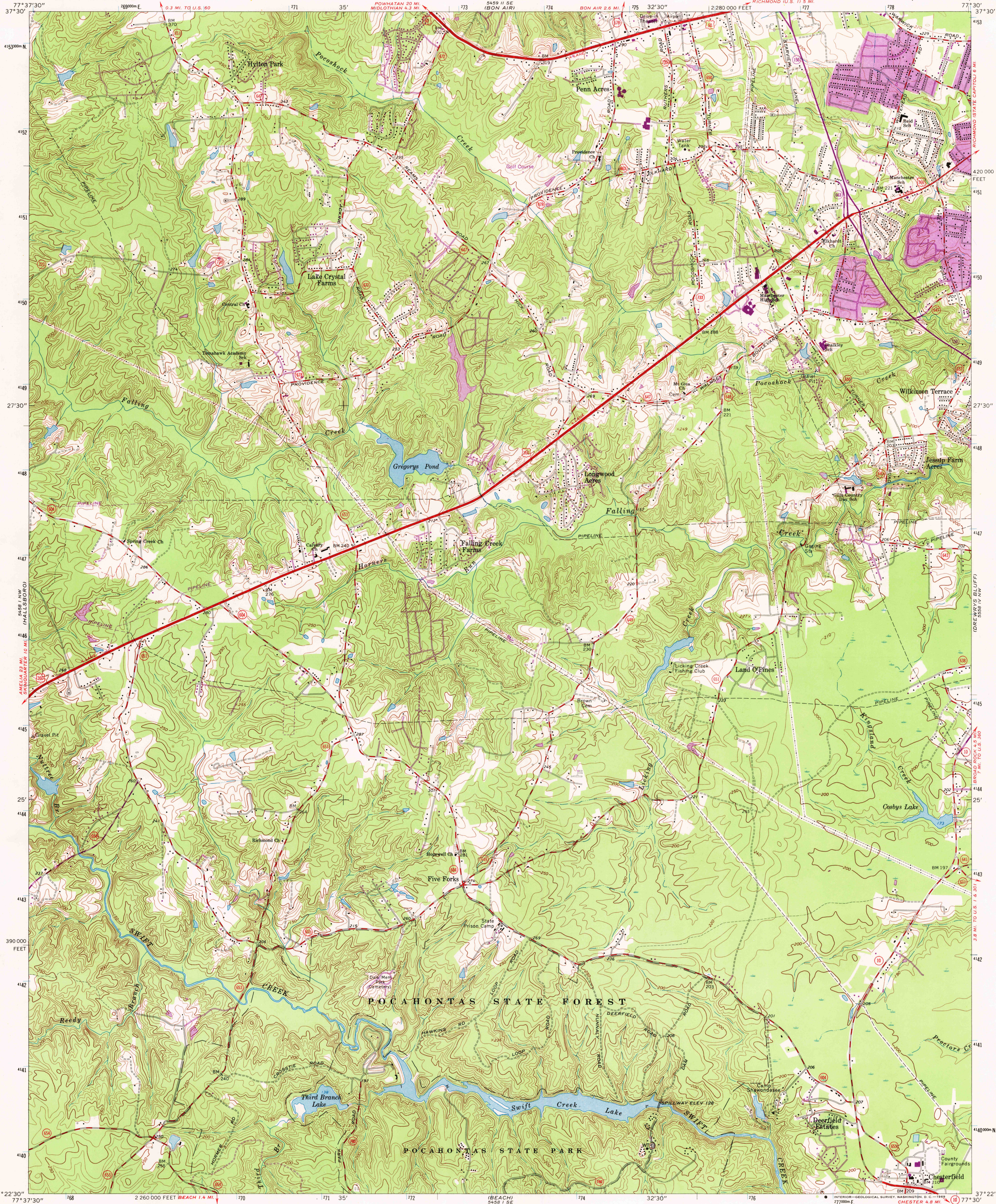

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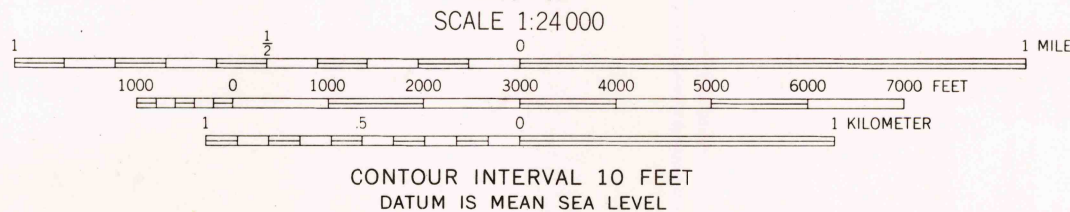
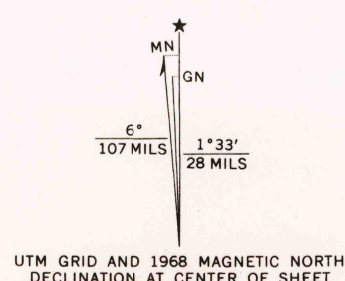
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1962. Field checked 1963. Supersedes Army Map Service map dated 1943.

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.

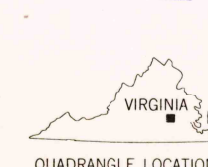
Revisions shown in purple compiled from aerial photographs taken 1968. This information not field checked.
