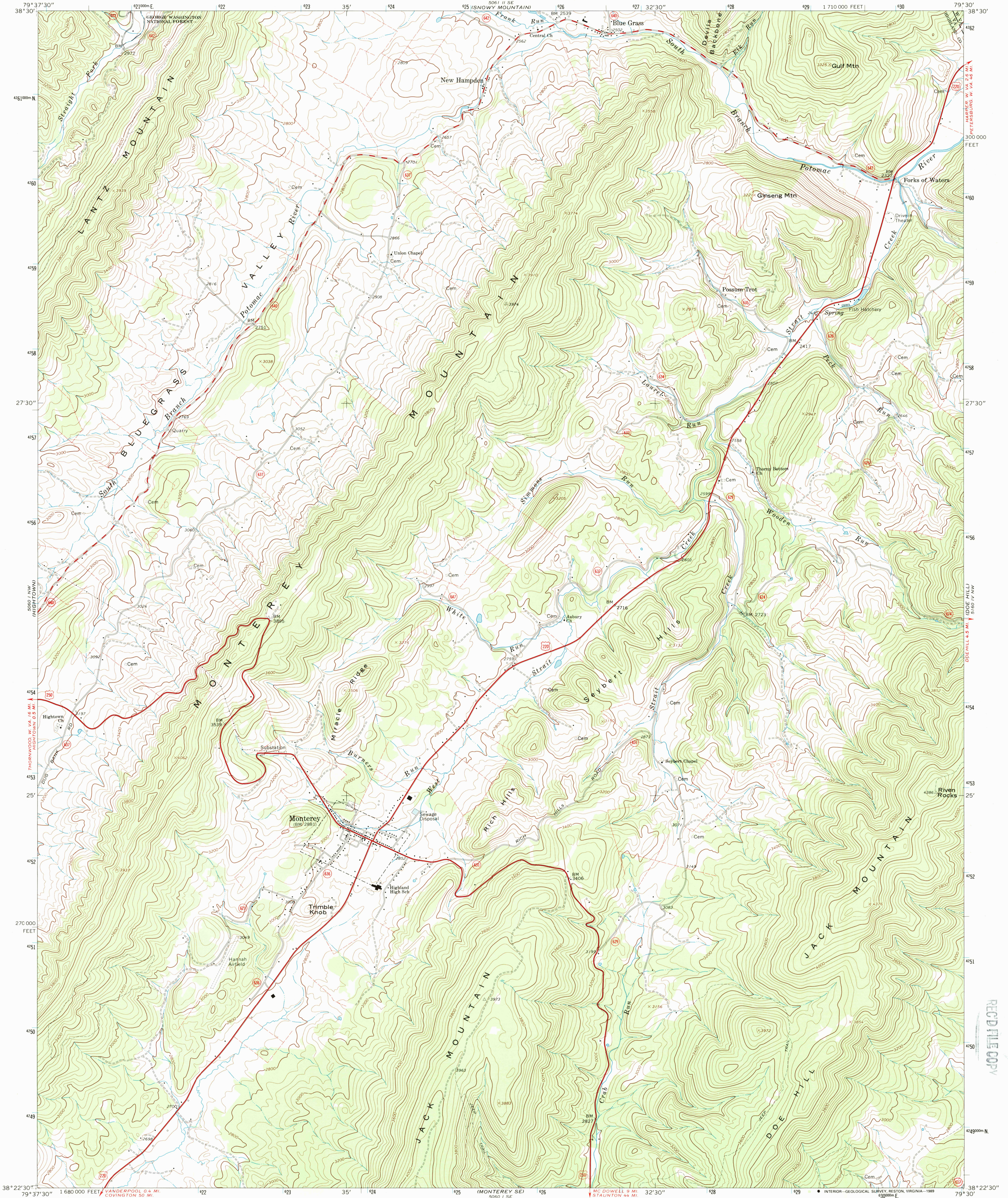

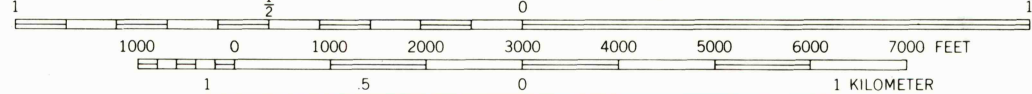
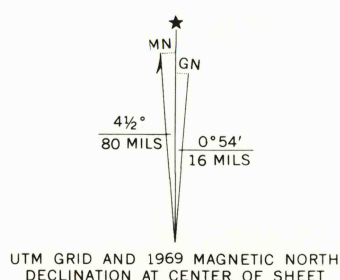
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 8 meters south and 20 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
