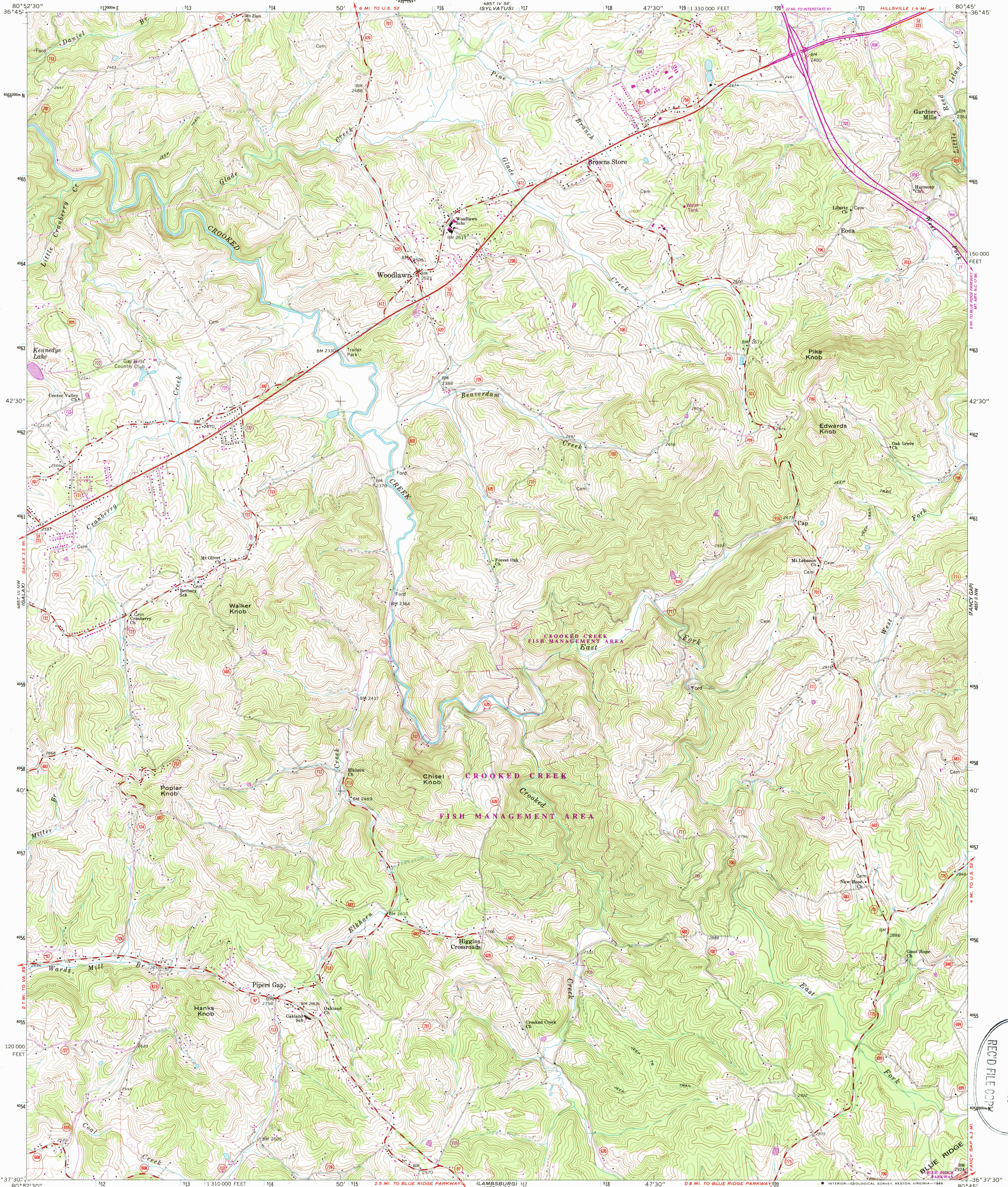

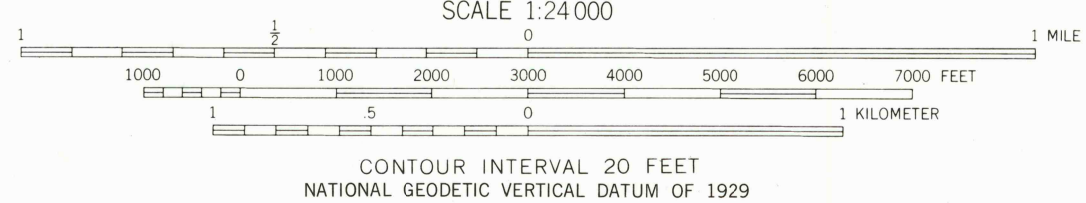
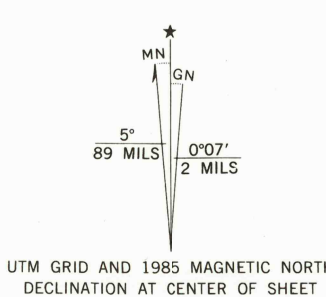

Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Virginia coordinate system, south zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 9 meters south and 17 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
