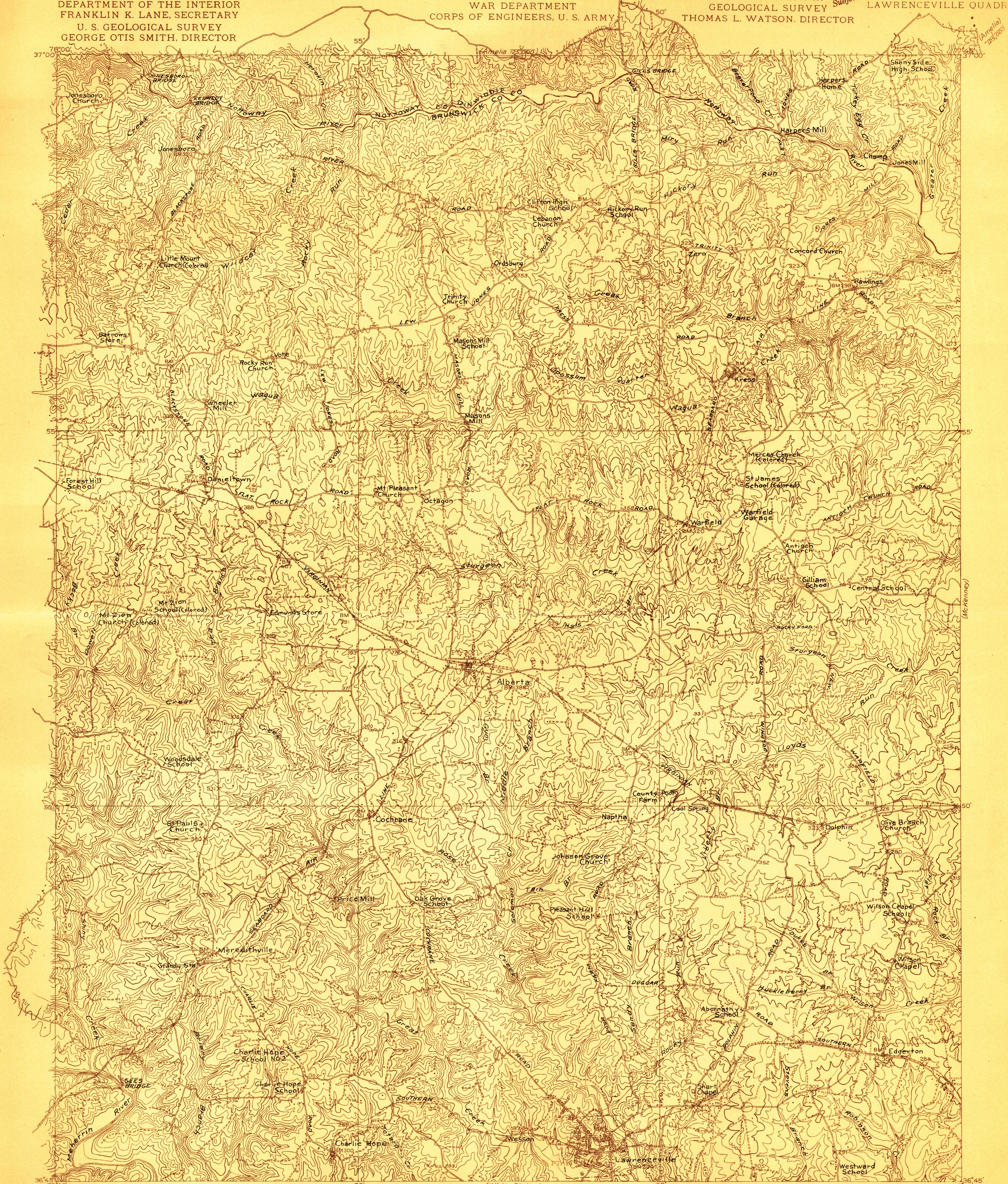

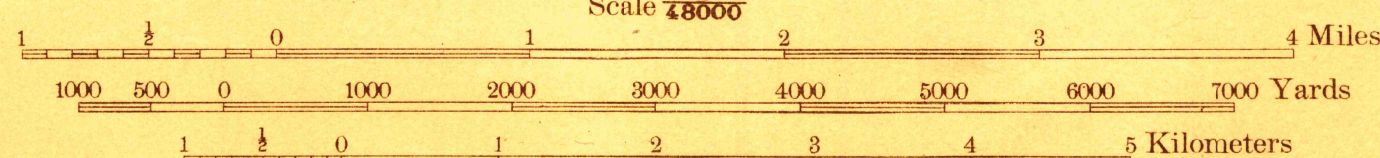
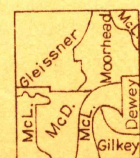

LAWRENCEVILLE QUADRANGLE

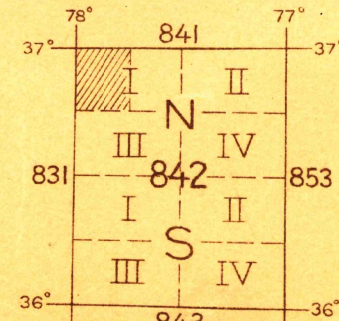
