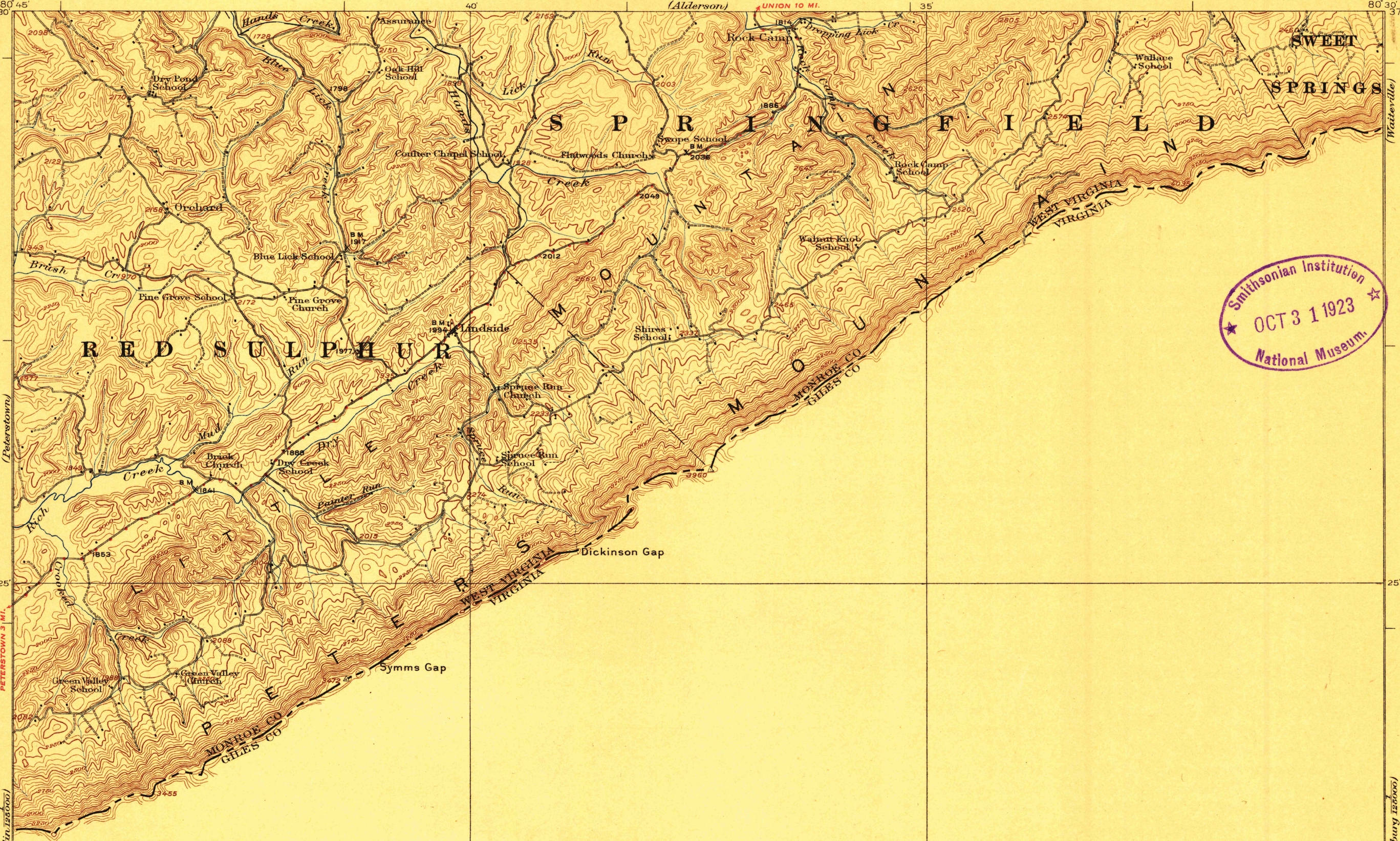




This area is shown on the map of Dublin
