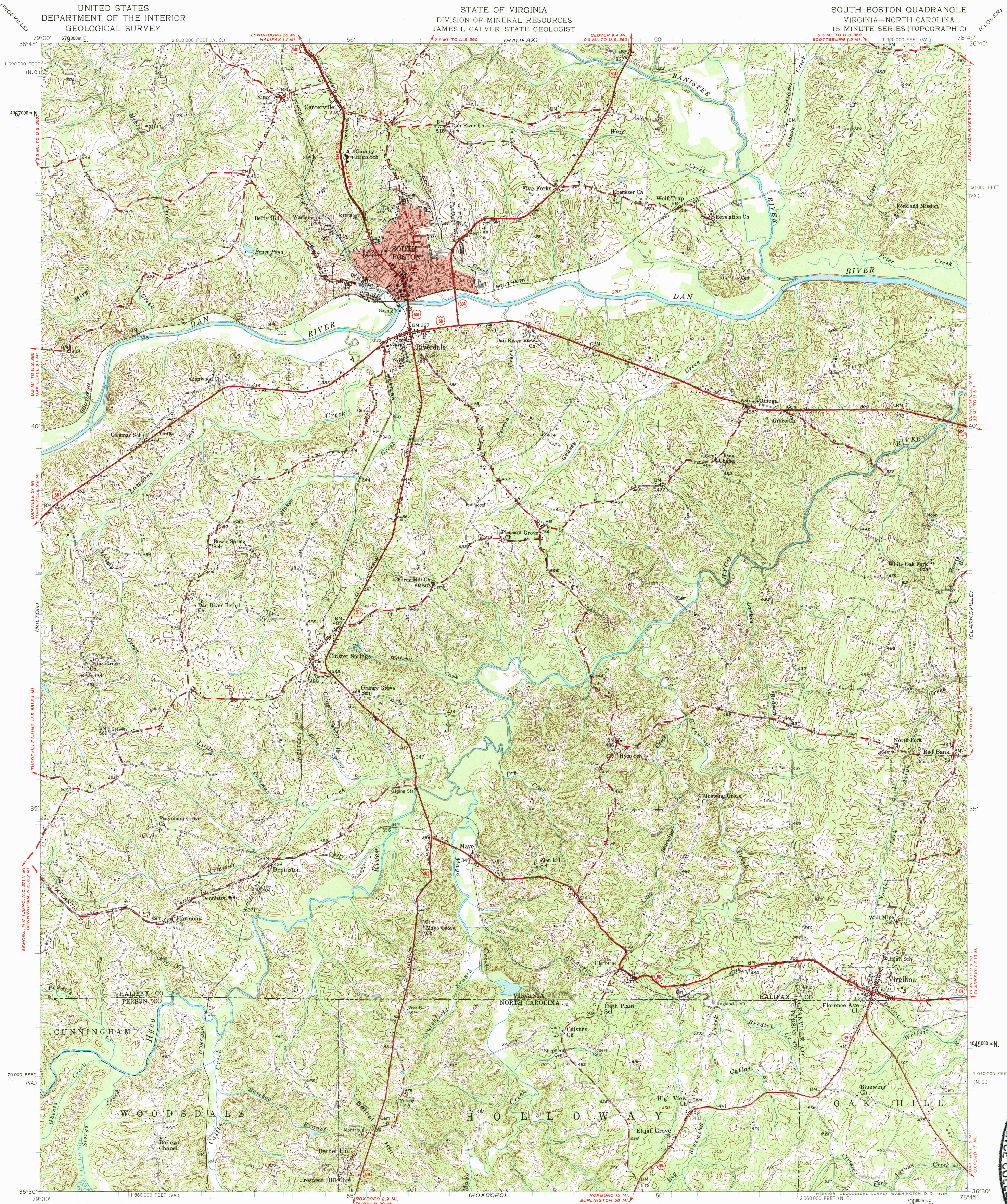

15 MINUTE SERIES (TOPOGRAPHIC)

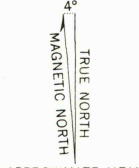

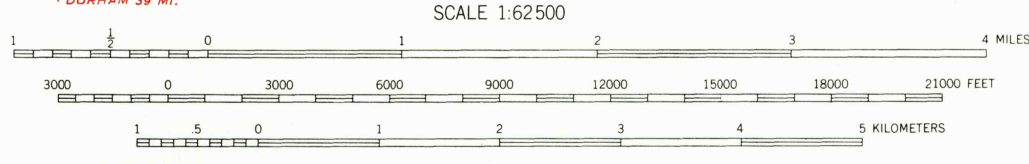
Polyconic projection, 1927 North American datum

No major culture or drainage changes observed



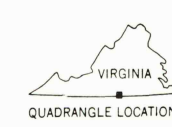
APPROXIMATE MEAN
