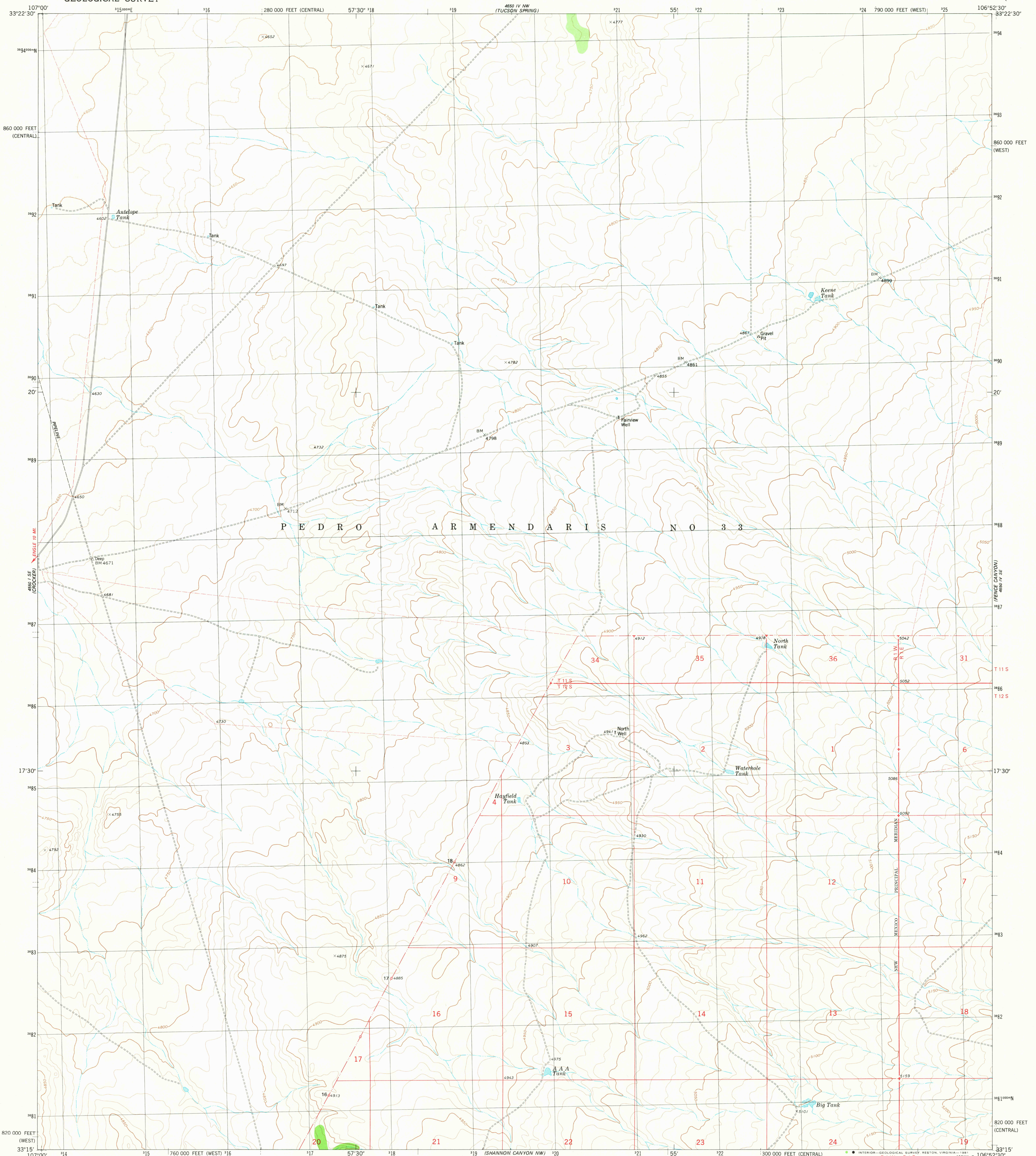

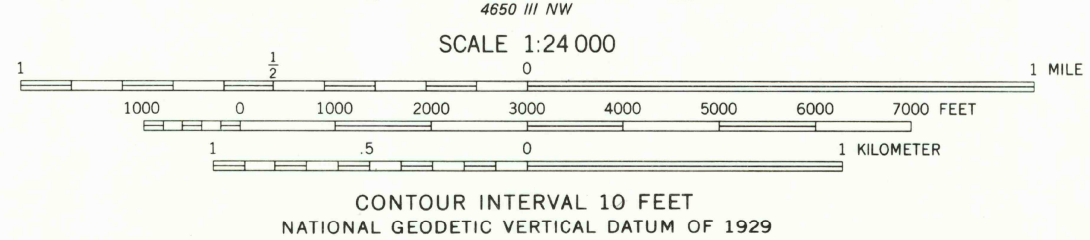
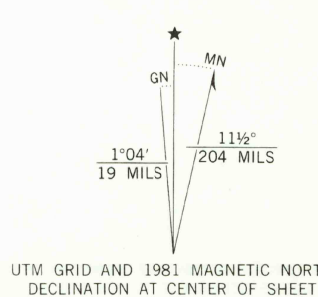
10,000-foot grid ticks based on New Mexico coordinate system, west and central zones
