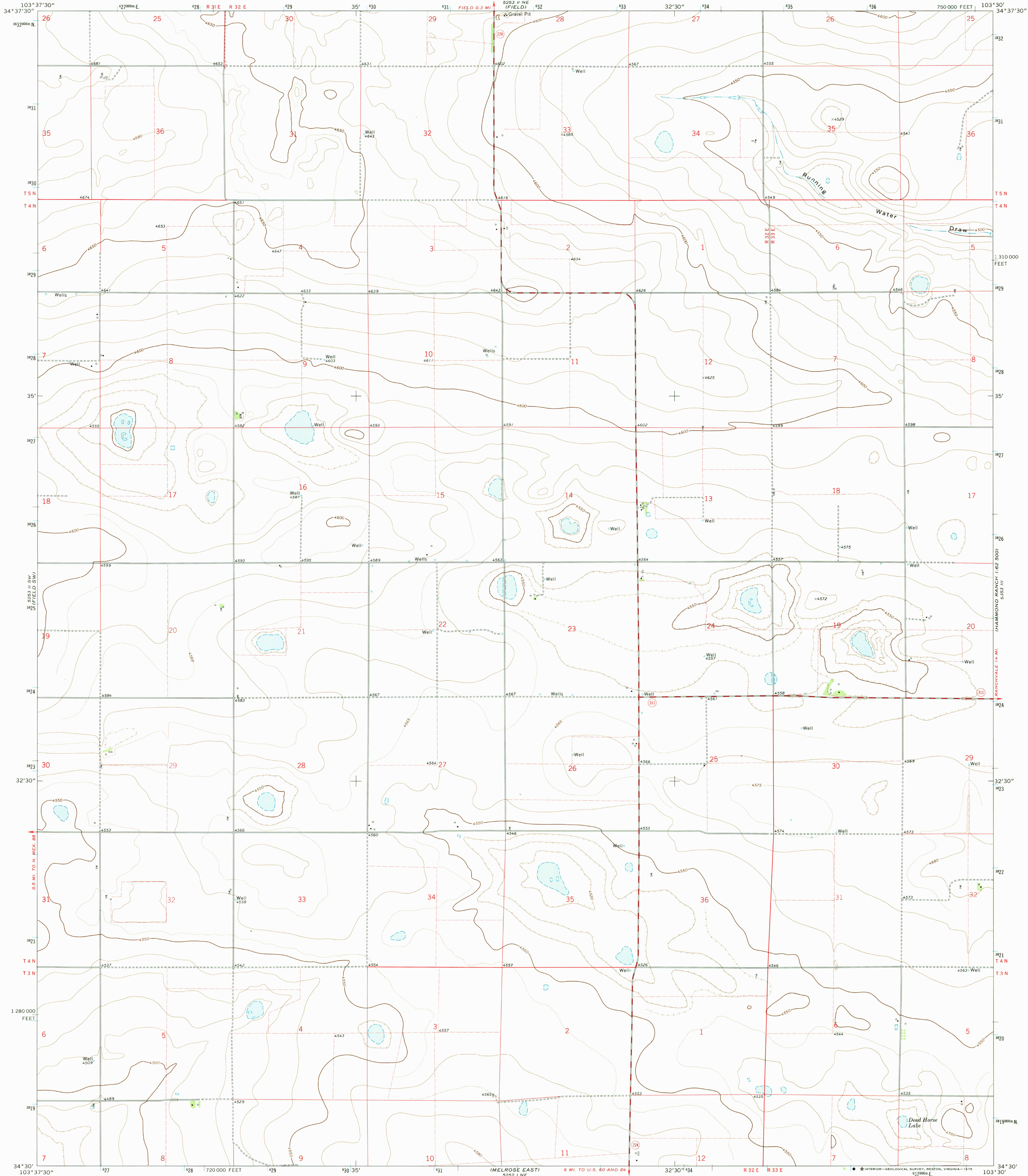

coordinate system, east zone (transverse Mercator)

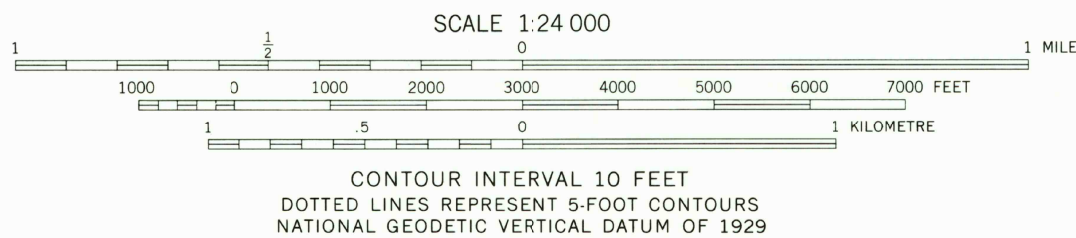
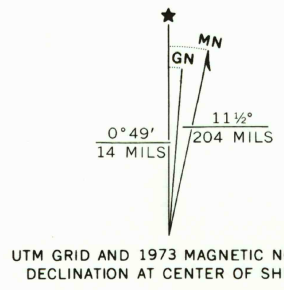
1000-metre Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
