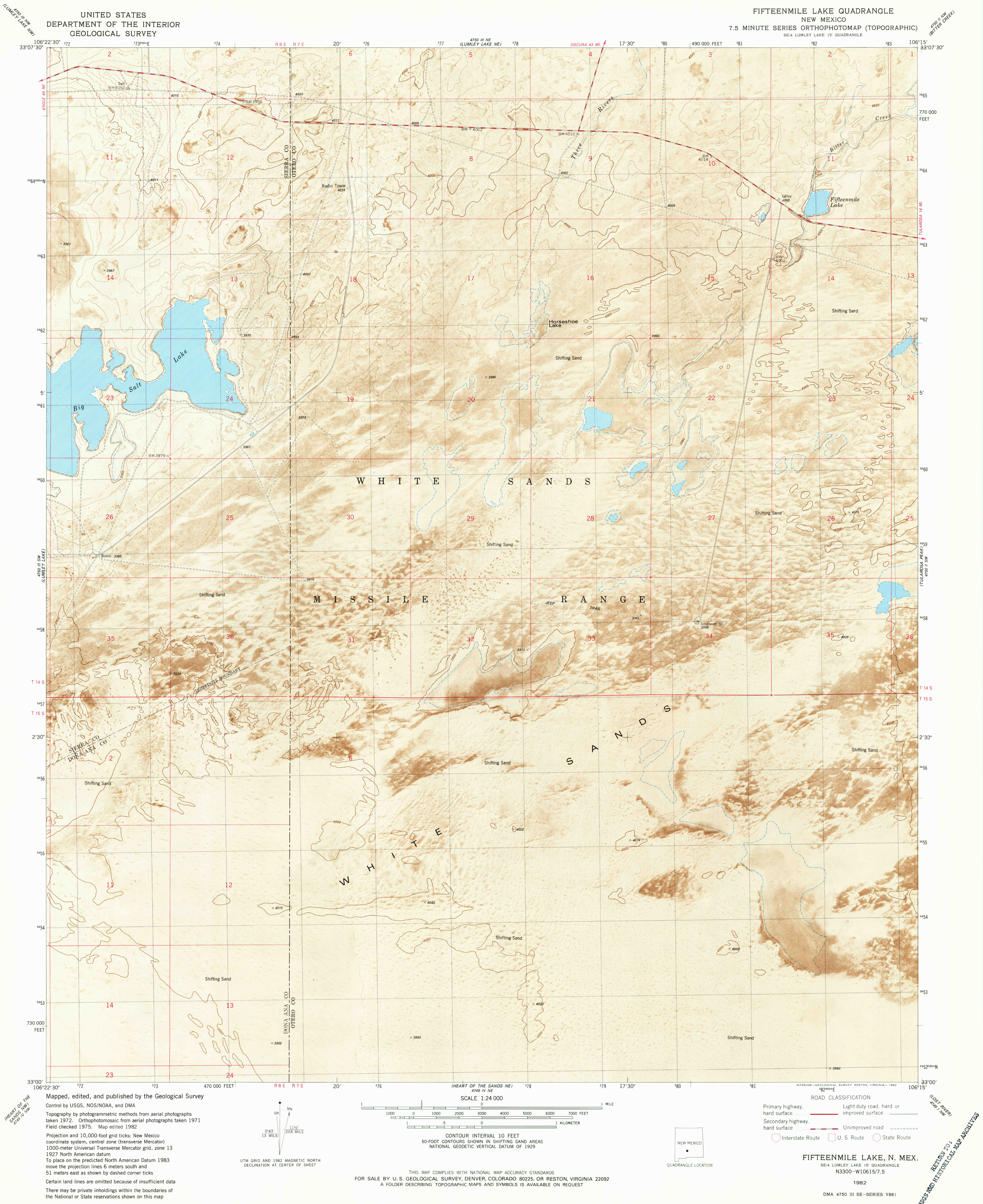

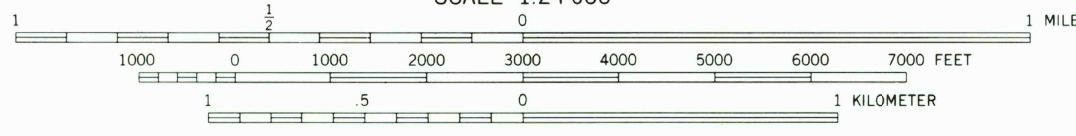
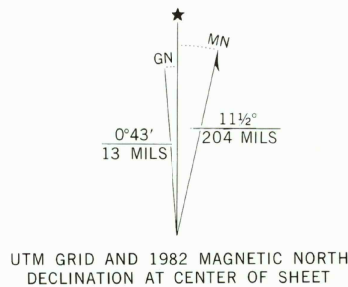

1927 North American datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters south and 51 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
