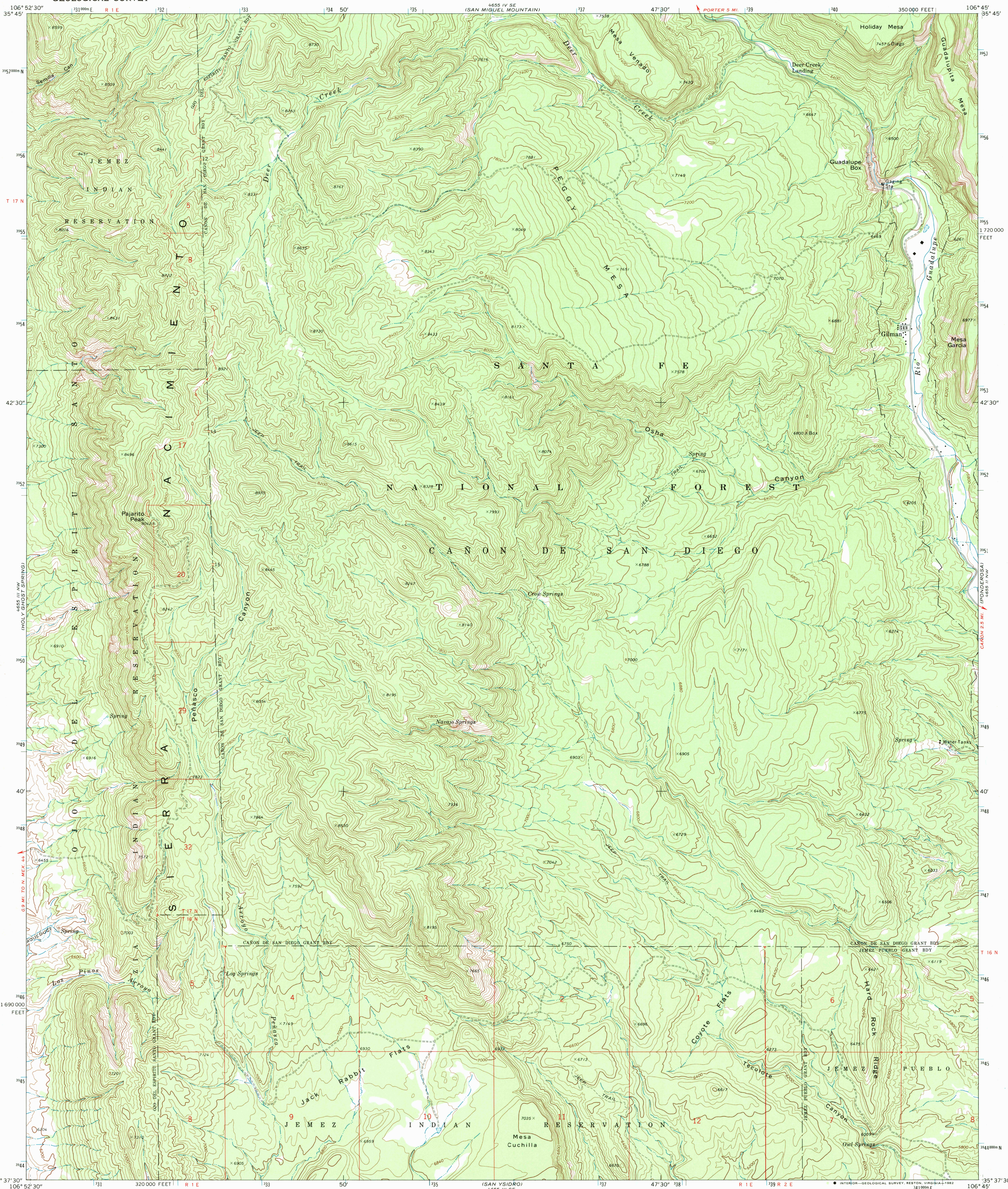

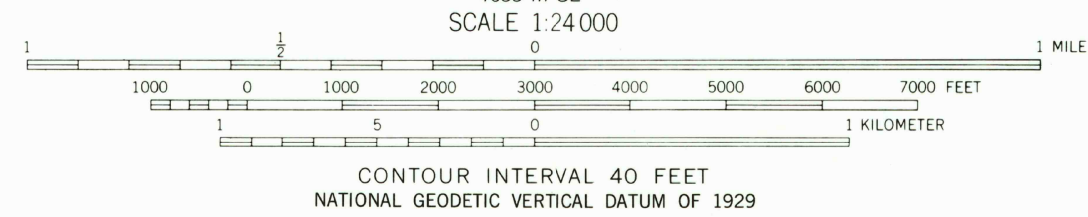
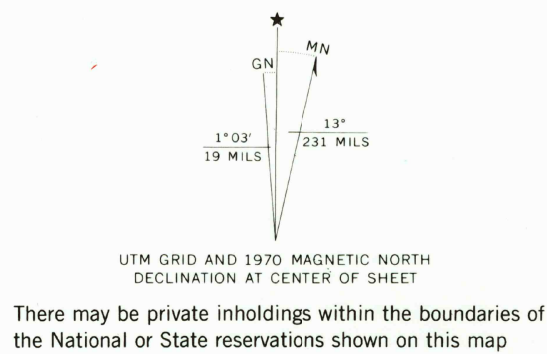

zone 13, shown in blue

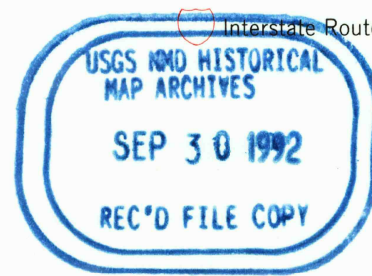
Where omitted, land lines have not been established
