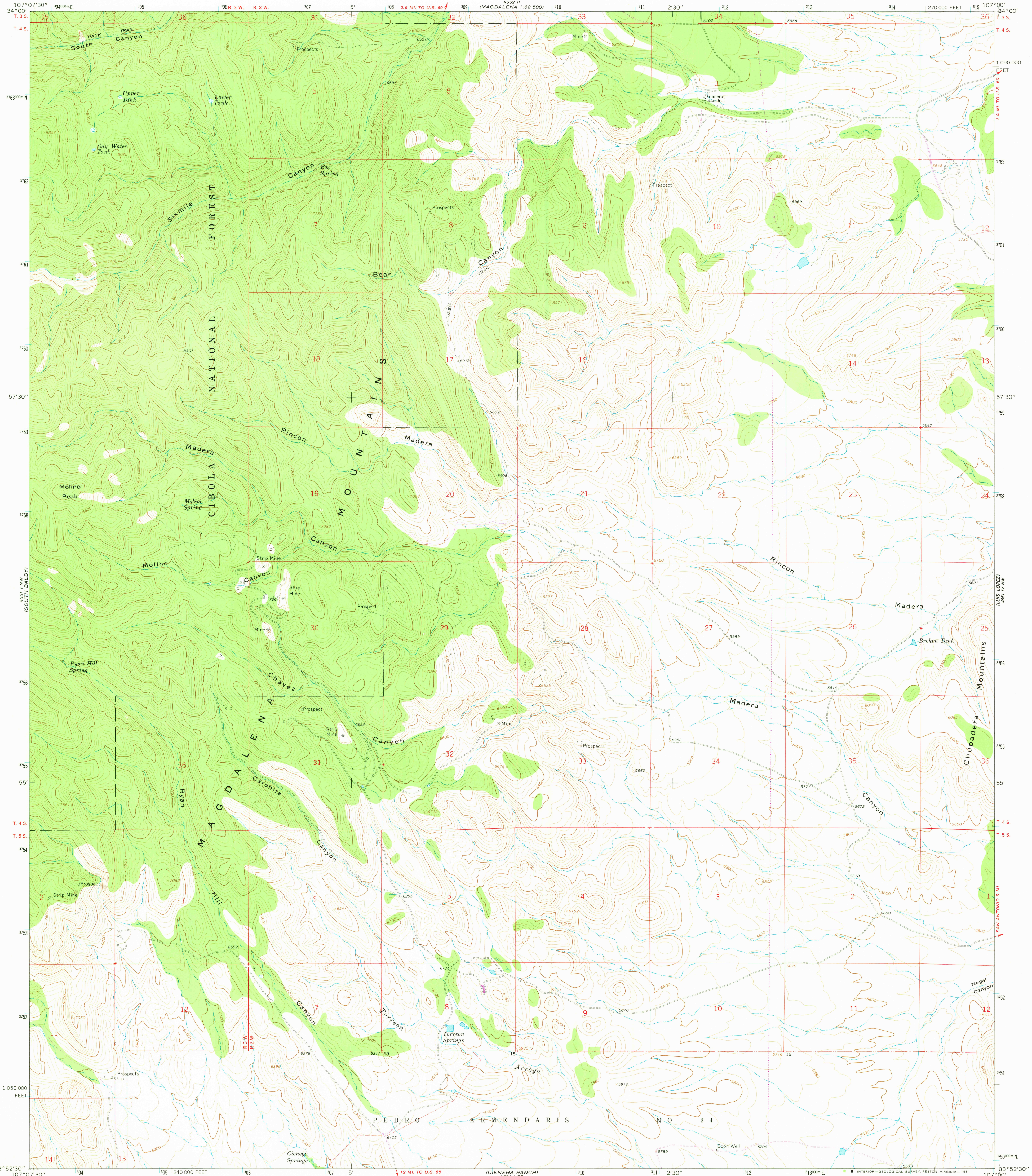

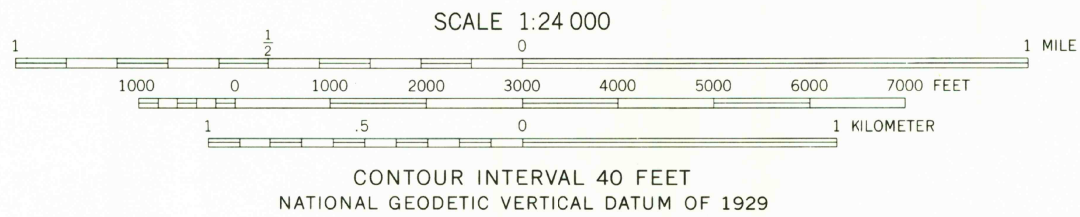
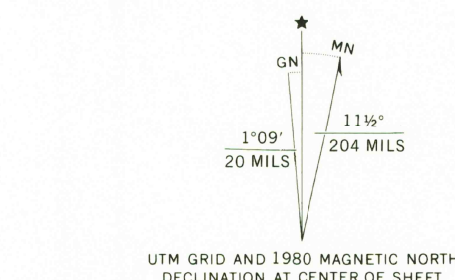
Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on New Mexico coordinate system, central zone
