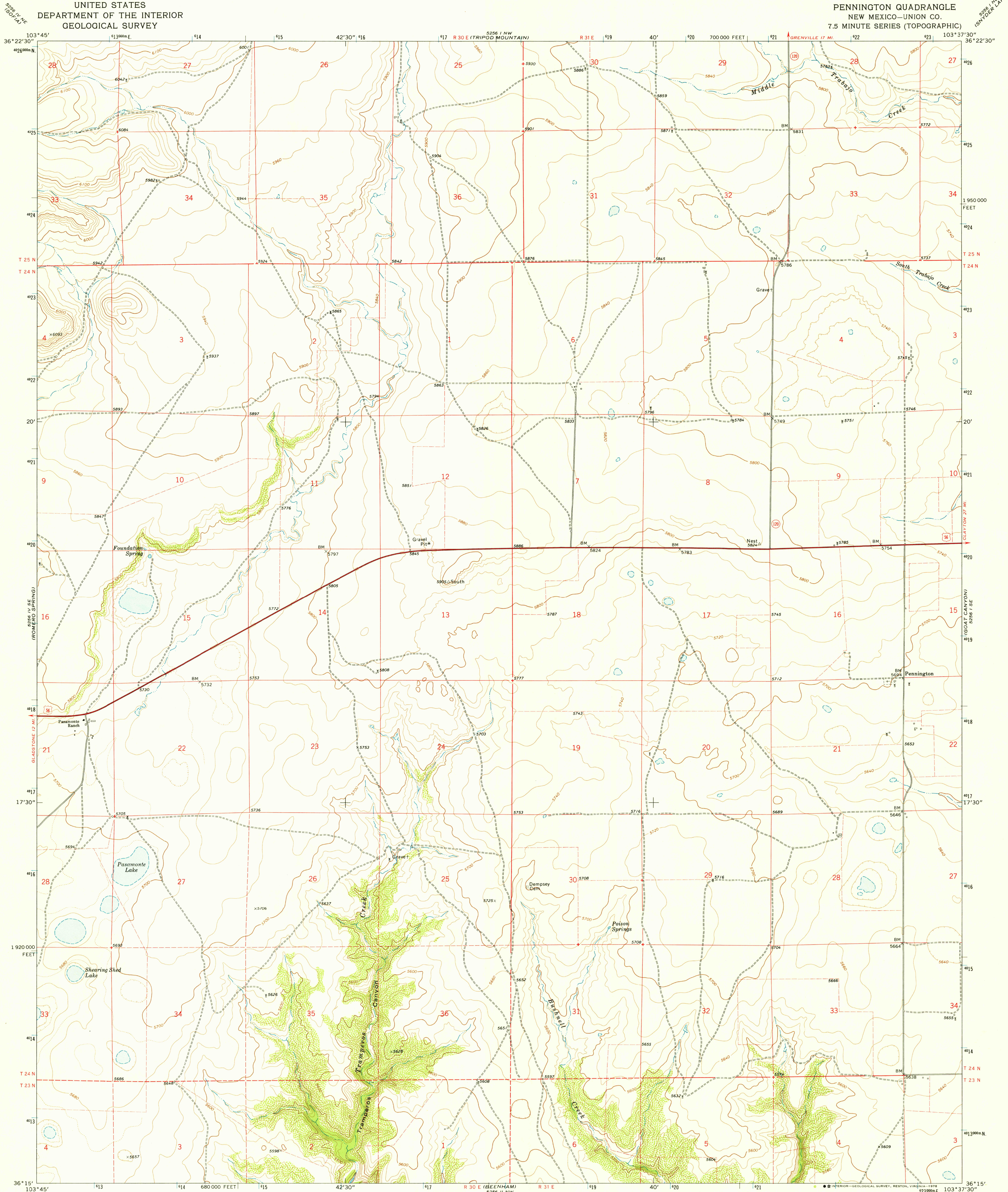

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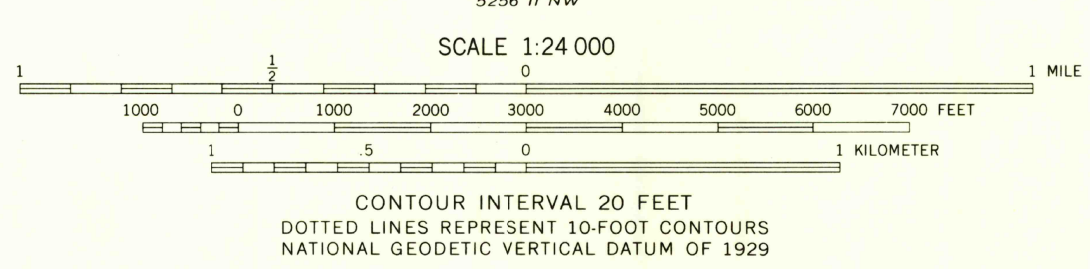
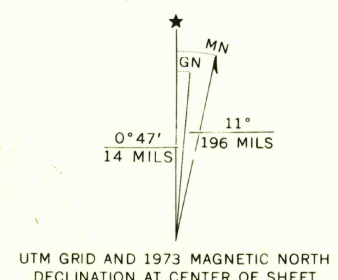
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1972. Field checked 1973
