

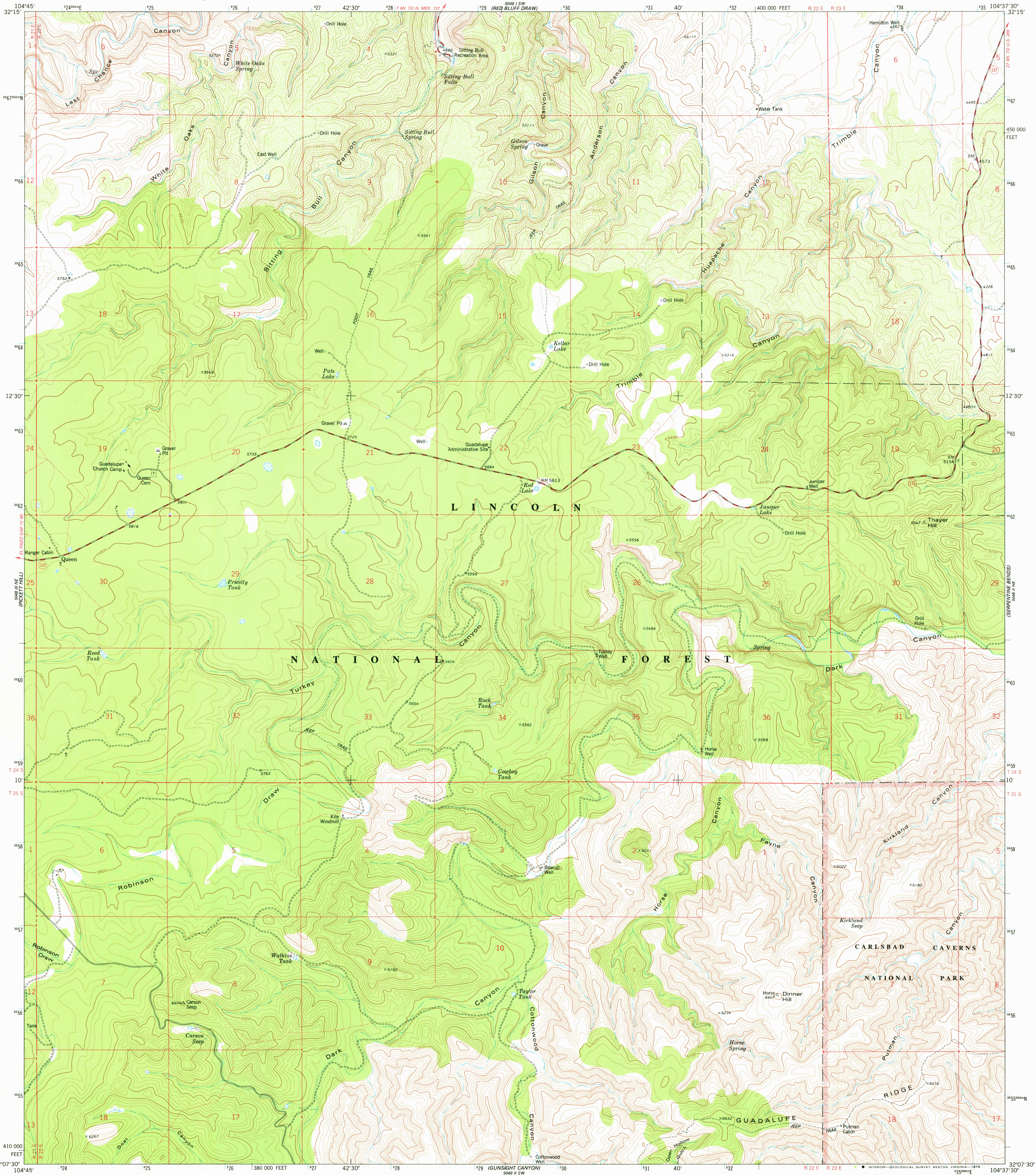

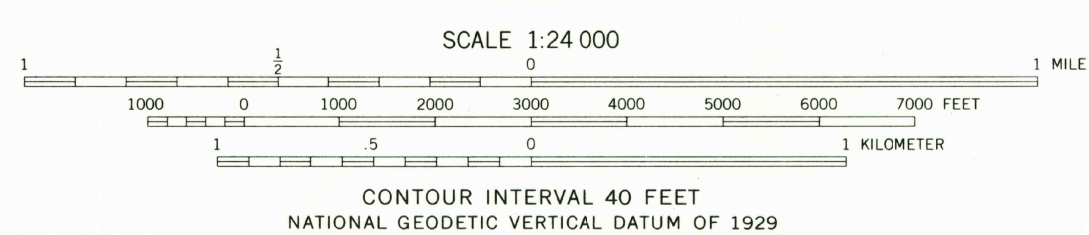
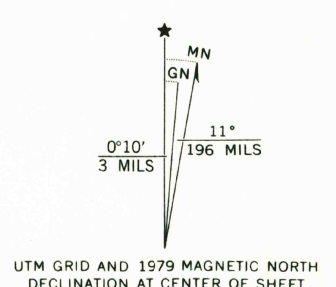
QUEEN QUADRANGLE
