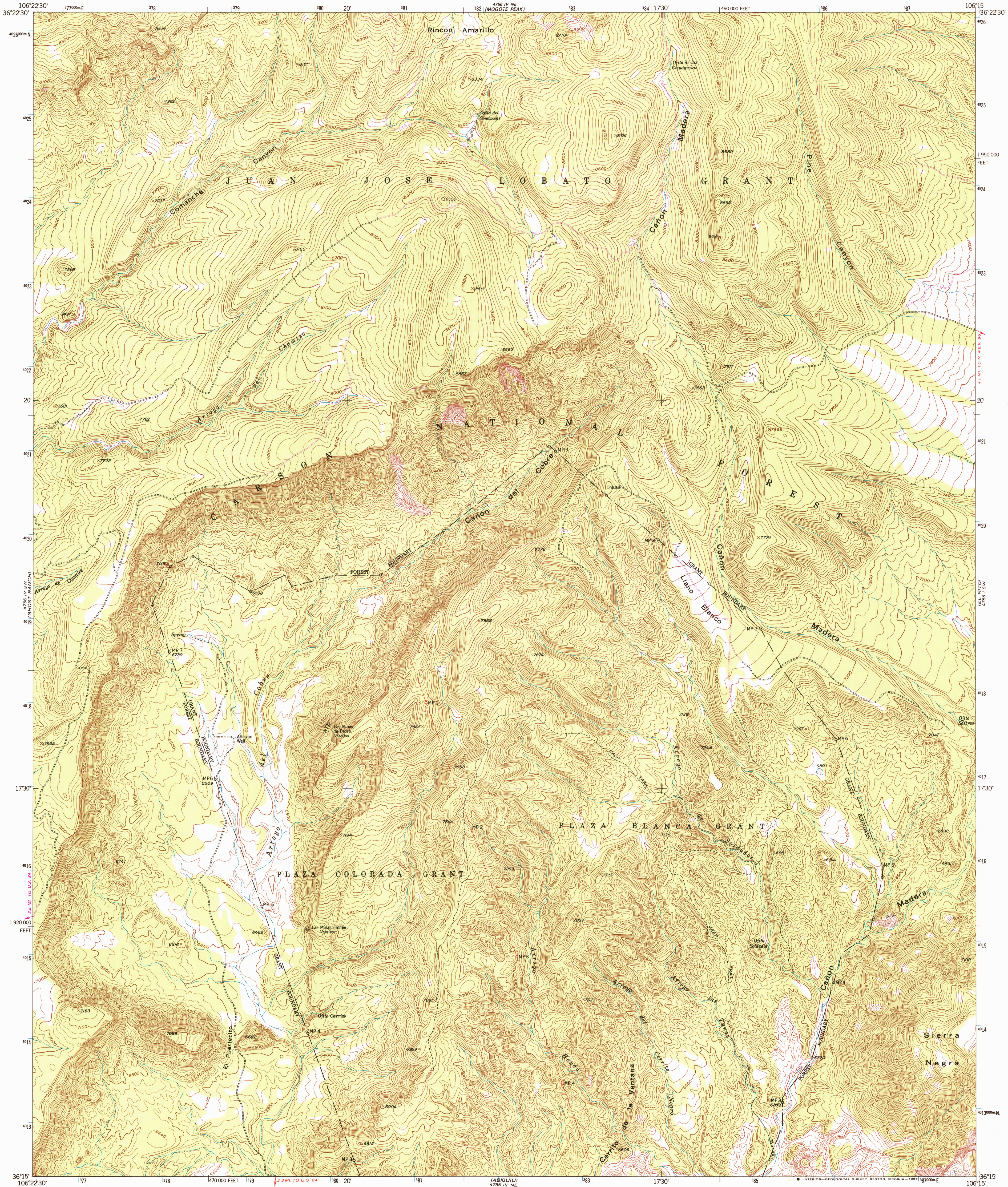

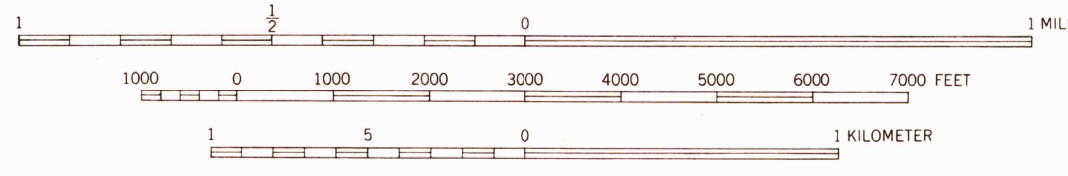
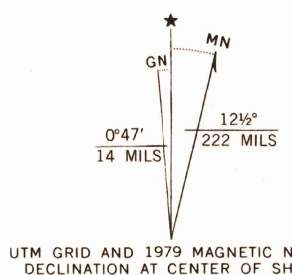
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum

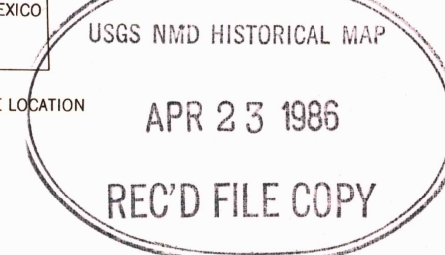
