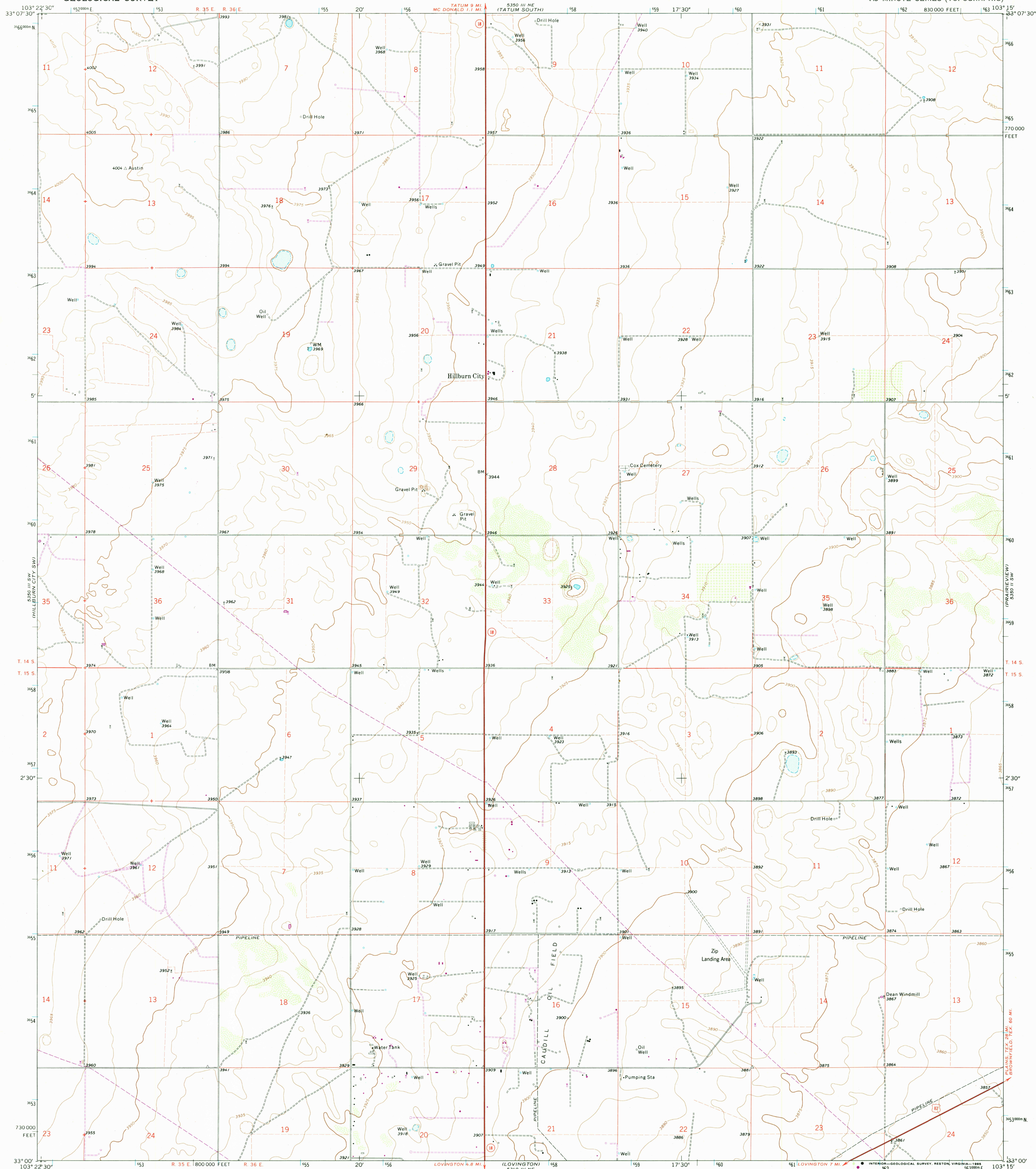

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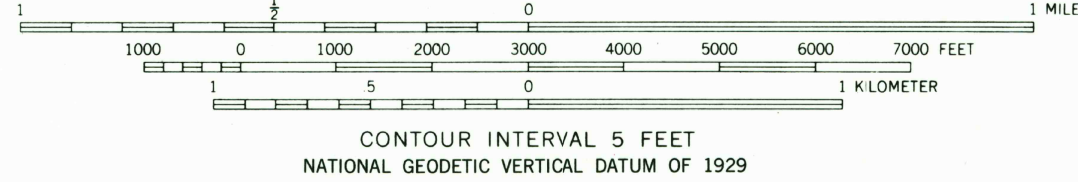
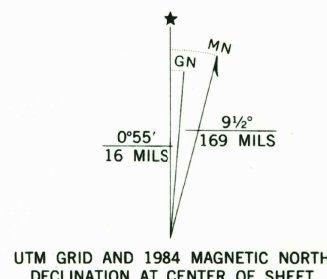
Planimetry by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1968. Topography by planetable surveys 1970

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 8 meters south and 45 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
