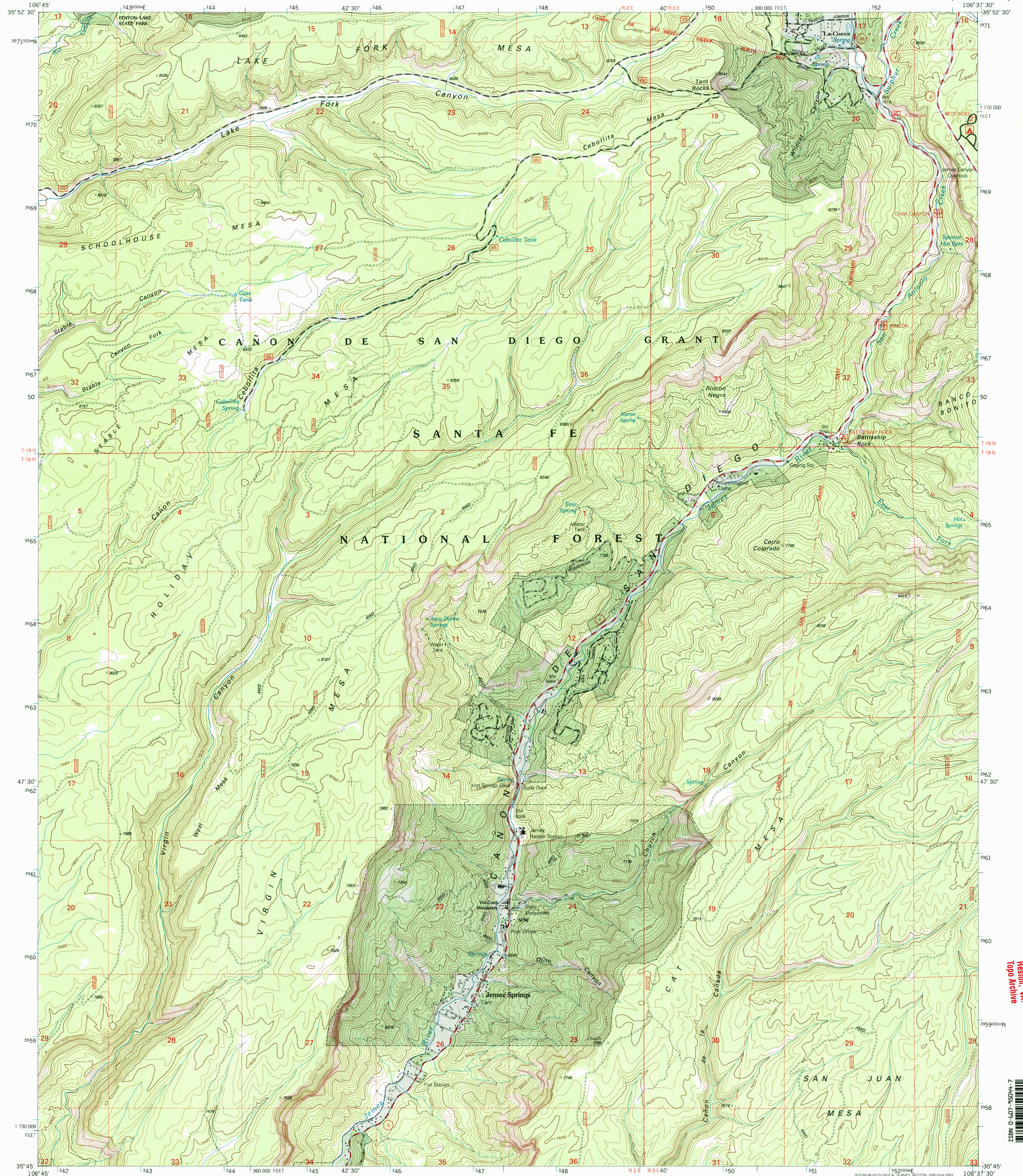

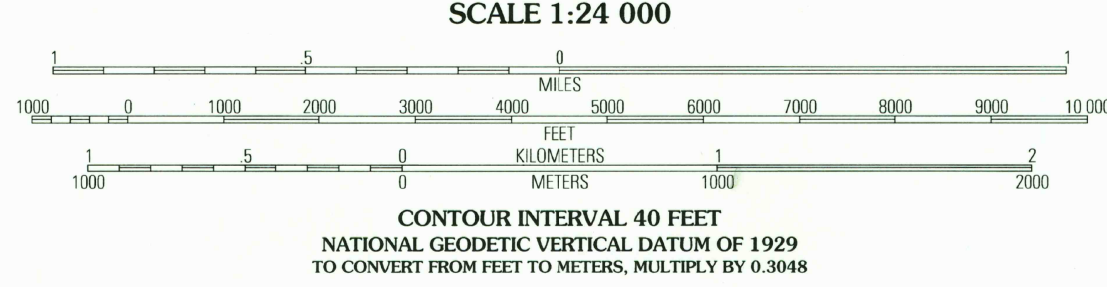
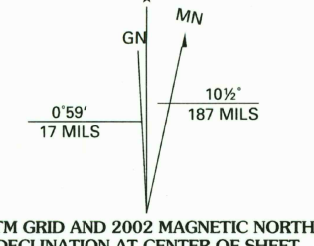
North American Datum of 1927 (NAD 27). Projection and 10 000-foot ticks:
